THOUGHTS FOR MEDITATION

SR2: 16.1 - "Though truths are revealed through inspired channels, the instrument of iniquity has often mixed them with error. Such iniquitous workers oft times resort to the use of portions of divine revelation, unlawfully using them as an entering wedge to pass on error and thus deceive the simple. Let none flatter themselves that they can escape the clutches of the devil by the studious effort of another. Everyone must study for himself to

understand his own position, and with candid mind be ready to listen to all with a teachable spirit of a child. 'Verily I say unto you, Whoever shall not receive the kingdom of God as a little child, he shall not enter therein.' (Mark 10:15.) Prejudice, has beguiled and ruined more souls than any trap ever devised by the great deceiver. The one who refuses to listen to reasons offered by another, is the most ignorant. Such a man is usually

prejudiced because the argument presented contradicts his view of the subject, or it may be that he considers himself more intellectual or of superior social standing. Others will not hear the truth because it hurts their sinful conscience and for fear that they must part from some selfish lust. This class is under the power of the devil, and on the way to everlasting ruin -- sinning against the Holy Ghost. Those who are sincere in their errors are the very ones who are found in the bottom of the devil's kidnaping bag. This class is the hardest to convince that they are on the way to hell."

1TG32: 19.3 - "Although God anciently permitted the peoples' teachers (their prophets) to be pushed into a corner, abused, and slaughtered, He will permit it no longer. The eyes of His people shall see their Godappointed teachers as they are brought to the front."

SR2: 15.3 - "The term 'prophet' as used in the Bible... is employed to designate men and women engaged in a wide range of service in connection with the work of God. Some of these never uttered a proph-ZECHARIAH FOUR ecy as that term is generally understood... Some were used only for a special occasion, others for a long series of years. Some wrote out the message God revealed to them, and others gave them orally. To some, as in the case of Daniel and others, were committed prophecies reaching into the distant future, portions of which are still un-

SR2: 15.4 — "Some were God's messengers raised up in periods of great crisis, to warn the church and the world of threatened judgments, and to call men back to allegiance to God. Such were Samuel, Elijah, John the Baptist, and others. John disclaimed the prophetic title, claiming rather that he was a voice or a messenger of God, sent to prepare the way of the Lord in calling Israel

to repentance. But as God's messenger he was declared by Christ to be a prophet, and 'even more than a prophet.' Luke 7:26. 'Surely the Lord will do nothing, but He revealeth His secrets unto His servants the prophets.' Amos 3:7. - 'The Present Truth,' Vol. 5, No. 72."

SR2: 15.5 — "In the highest sense the prophet was one who spoke by direct inspiration, communicating to the people the messages he had received from God. But the name was given also to those who, though not so directly inspired, were divinely called to instruct the people in the works and ways of God.' -'Education,' p. 46."

Amos 1:2-- "The Lord will roar from Zion, and utter His voice from Jerusalem; and the habitations of the shepherds shall mourn, and the top of Carmel shall wither."

> 2TG41: 7.3 - "Thisscripture, you see, reflects the tragedy which took place on the top of Carmel in the days of Elijah. Here we are given the hint that there is to be another show-down be-

tween the prophet of God and the prophets of Baal. The prophets of Baal in our day even boast that they are not inspired, that what they teach and preach is what they themselves discovered by deep study and research! They even sneer at those who claim to be inspired of the Lord! They seem to think that God has forsaken the earth; that He cares not to send His Spirit as in former time; that men are now so wise that what the Spirit can do for them, they themselves can do even better! The truth is, though, that if there ever was a need for inspired interpreters of the Scriptures, it is today while many winds of doctrines are blowing from all directions, bringing in confusion, dissension, and disaster everywhere. No one sees eye to eye!"

SPIRIT OF PROPHECY

We will continue where we left off in the previous issue of the Symbolic Code. Upon trimming their lamps, the wise virgins also realized they were asleep to the depths of the truths they had accepted. Their refusal of the majority to share their oil with the foolish virgins also stemmed from the startling realization that they did not know how to teach that which they had received, for they accepted the Message but continued to sleep. The wise virgins were now wide awake, fearful that their inability to teach would cause them to be rejected. Their study of the truths they have so long accepted was now being undertaken with more fear than that of the foolish virgins. Both the foolish and the wise virgins were studying as never before, the former acquiring to obey and the latter trimming their lamps to teach; they had no time for each other. Many of the wise, along with the foolish virgins, realized that there had been a prophet, the living Spirit of Prophecy, in the church. The realization of the foolish turned out to be fatal, whereas the wise were now ready for--

THE ONLY REMEDY FOR THE CHURCH AND THE WORLD

"The only remedy for our churches, for our families, and for individuals, is entire conformity to the will and character of God. Unless God shall work through the two olive-trees, his witnesses, causing them to empty from themselves the golden oil through the golden tubes into the golden bowl, and hence to the burning lamps, representing the church, no one will

be safe for a moment from the machinations of Satan. He will, if possible, deprave human nature, and assimilate it to his own corrupt principles. But this golden oil will revive the Spirit of God in the heart of man. A Christlike principle will be introduced which will be like leaven. Through the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, satanic agencies will be overcome." --

RH, September 14, 1897 par. 6

points out the system which Heaven has ordained for dispensing the Word of the Lord to His church: that the Spirit of Prophecy at work is the only remedy against isms in the church and in the world."

1TG14: 20.2 — "Those who do not avail themselves of the golden oil, and those who continue ever to hunt for some kind of oil, or whoever try to extract their own, will, of course, drop into the pit when the earth opens her mouth to swallow up the flood. Then it is that ism-breathers and ism-seekers shall forever pass away."

1TG14: 23.1 — "Obviously, the system of Bible interpretation, described by Zechariah, is the Lord's **only system**. It is the only remedy for isms and discord among Christians. Thus it is that His 'watchmen shall lift up the voice; with the voice together shall they sing: for they shall see eye to eye, when the Lord shall bring again Zion.' Isa. 52:8."

> "Read and study the fourth <mark>chapter of Zechariah</mark>. The two olive trees empty the golden oil out of themselves through the golden pipes into the golden bowl from which the lamps of the sanctuary are fed. The golden oil represents the Holy Spirit. With this oil God's ministers are to be

constantly supplied, that they, in turn, may impart it to church. 'Not by might, nor by power, but by My Spirit, saith the Lord of hosts.' God's servants can obtain victories only by inward purity, by cleanness of heart, by holiness. It is of the utmost importance that ministers set a right example. If they follow lax, loose principles, their example is quoted by those who are doing wrong as a vindication of their course. The whole synagoque of Satan is watching for defects in the lives of God's representatives, and the most is made of every defect. -- RH, December 22, 1904." -- TM 188.2



1TG14: 20.1 - "The symbolism, therefore,

TN6: 16.2 — "Besides being taught by the literal testimonies of the prophets, the gospel is taught also by figurative prophecies. In our immediate concern, therefore, with the Spirit's teachings as to how God reveals unto men His written Word, we must give consideration not only to the literal but also to the figurative testimonies of the prophets. And as the fourth chapter of Zechariah is a pictorial disclosure of the way in which God reveals His Word, we are led thereto for an exposition of The Figurative Mode of Inspired Interpretation."



SR2: 283.1 — "The anti-typical symbols of the second temple (the type), were shown to Zechariah in vision and recorded in the fourth chapter of his prophecy as follows:"

Zech. 4:1-- "And the angel that talked with me came again, and waked me, as a man that is wakened out of his sleep,"

Zech. 4:2-- "And said unto me, What seest thou? And I said, I have looked, and behold a candlestick all [of] gold, with a bowl upon the top of it, and his seven lamps thereon, and seven pipes to the seven lamps, which [are] upon the top thereof:"

Zech. 4:3-- "And two olive trees by it, one upon the right [side] of the bowl, and the other upon the left [side] thereof."

Zech. 4:4-- "So I answered and spake to the angel that talked with me, saying, What [are] these, my Lord?"

1TG14: 17.3 - "The illustration here exhibited, you note, is an exact reproduction of Zechariah's symbolism. In order that our study be simplified and vivid, we shall study the chapter along with the illustration."

Note carefully that this illustration is an

exact reproduction of Zechariah's symbolism. In other words, it is a pictorial interpretation of Zechariah's vision by the Lord's prophet, Brother V. T. Houteff, published five different times in the years 1932, 1937, 1942, 1944, and 1953, respectively in the following publications: The Shepherd's Rod, Volume 2, page 270; The Symbolic Code, Volume 3, Nos. 3, 4, page 2; Tract No. 6, page 18; The Answerer Book 3, page 31; and Timely Greetings, Vol. 1, No. 14, page 18. We should also note that the servant of the Lord made no modifications to his inspired pictorial interpretation.

5SC1-5: 3.1.1 — "Let all Present Truth believers carefully study the fourth chapter of Zechariah, and take particular notice of the method there illustrated, which God employs to reveal truth to His people. ..."

TN6: 24.3 — "This symbolic unit, having demonstrated that <mark>the Bible can be rightly</mark> interpreted only by the Spirit that dictated <u>It</u>, shows that <u>the church can be led into all</u> Truth only by this Spirit-controlled method: through the interpreters (the two golden pipes), who alone are qualified and enabled to bring forth meat in due season (golden oil) from the Scriptures (olive trees) into the storehouse (golden bowl) of Present Truth; and in turn through the ministers (seven

tubes), who alone are to pass on from the bowl the oil to the church (candlestick), that it might illumine with the light of life this dark and dying world of ours."

TN6: 25.1 - "Here in pictorial lesson God is unmistakably teaching that He controls the Scriptures and that He reveals them when a need arises, just as Joseph controlled all the grain in the storehouses of ancient Egypt, to hand it out in the time of famine. And as only through him could the Israelites, as well as the Egyptians, obtain grain in time of want, so likewise only from Christ, the King, through His Spirit-filled instrumentalities --Josephs (His specially appointed interpreters of the dreams and the visions which the Bible contains, whether they be to rebuke and enlighten the church or to forewarn the Gentiles) -- can we obtain the 'oil' which God has placed in the Bible."

1TG14: 18.1 - "Now let ushear the angel's explanation of this symbolism."

Zech. 4:5-- "Then the angel that talked with me answered and said unto me, Knowest thou not what these be? And I said, No, my Lord."

Zech. 4:6-- "Then he answered and spake unto me, saying, This [is] the word of the LORD unto Zerubbabel, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the LORD of hosts.

ZECHARIAH FOUR

Let us first clear the false doctrine promulgating that this symbolism represents the work of the 144,000. Note in the following statements that the system is to His people, the church, whereas the work of the 144,000 is to all the world."

TN6: 19.4 - "This is the Word of the Lord unto Zerubbabel.' Zech. 4:6. The method which God is to use now, in the time of the end, in communicating with Zerubbabel -the governors or ministers of His people -- is laid down in the symbolism."

1TG14: 18.2 — "The angel disclosed two things: First he made known that the symbolism is concerning the Word of the Lord (the Bible) to the servants of God; second, that His Word is revealed, not by man's might nor by power, but by the Spirit of God."

1TG14: 18.3 — "Plainly this symbolism as a whole represents the system by which the Lord transmits His revealed Word to His people. That we might have a thorough understanding of this Divinely designed system, we need to know what each component part of the illustration stands for. The Spirit of Prophecy gives the clue. In The Great Controversy, page 267 is explained that the 'olive trees' represent the 'Old and New Testaments;' Testimonies to Ministers, page 188, says that the golden oil represents the Holy Spirit; and on page 337 of the same book, along with Revelation 1:20, says that

> the seven lamps represent the church, and that the seven tubes (the ministry) convey the oil to the churches."

1TG14: 19.2 - "Here is seen that the whole symbolical set up is for the purpose of depicting the accomplishment of but one thing -- of keeping the seven lamps (the entire church

membership) supplied spiritual oil (Bible Truth) so that it might give spiritual light all round about, that the church might lighten the world with the revealed Word of God...."

Let us not misinterpret the phrase, "the church might lighten the world with the revealed Word of God," to mean that this symbolism represents the work of the 144,000 to the world as some false teachers teach. The light remitted to the world when this symbolism is in action is a forewarning of things to come. Let us introduce some more statements in which a warning is given to the world--

1TG14: 20.1 - "The symbolism, therefore, points out the system which Heaven has ordained for dispensing the Word of the Lord to His church: that the Spirit of Prophecy at work is the only remedy against isms in the church and in the world."

TN6: 23.3 - "... The symbolism definitely points out that from them the ministers must get the light-producing truth with which to supply the church, so that it may brightly shine in this dark world, drawing to the light 'all men' who hate the darkness."

ABN1: 12.1 - "According to Revelation 1:20, the 'candlesticks' symbolize the churches, and the 'stars' the angels (leaders) who have charge over the churches. Being the attendants of the churches, the angels are thus seen to be the ministry, whose responsibility is to have the lamps trimmed, filled with oil, and burning brightly, so that the church may give light to all about her."

SPIRIT

ZECHARIAH FOUR

From the last three statements, we see that the system of **Zech**ariah Chapter Four is for the church to receive and reflect light in this dark world; thus, the world is drawn to the light for the period of the second fruits harvest.

When will this symbolism be fulfilled?--

TN6: 19.1 — "Establishing the time to which this figurative prophecy points, the Lord, speaking through the prophet Haggai, who prophesied at the same time as did the prophet Zechariah, says:

TN6: 19.2 — "And I will overthrow the throne of kingdoms, and I will destroy the strength of the kingdoms of the heathen; and I will overthrow the chariots, and those that ride in them; and the horses and their riders shall come down, every one by the sword of his brother. In that day, saith the Lord of hosts, will I take thee, O Zerubbabel, My servant, the son of Shealtiel, saith the Lord, and will make thee as a signet for I have chosen thee, saith the Lord of hosts." Hag. 2:22, 23.

TN6: 19.3 — "Meeting its fulfillment at the end of the world when God is to overthrow the thrones and destroy the kingdoms of the earth,

Haggai's prophecy shows that Zerubbabel, the Lord's servant is a type of His servants today, who necessarily, therefore, are the antitypical 'signet.' And as Zechariah's vision, moreover, has never been understood until now, it can be speaking directly only to us at this time. Since, accordingly, his illustration of 'the Word of the Lord unto Zerubbabel' is to find its fulfillment today, we ought then to give the most studious attention as Inspiration Explains the Symbolism."

1TG10: 23.1 - "Here we are told that in the day God destroys the strength of the heathen kingdoms, which event is yet future, He makes ancient Zerubbabel 'a signet' of a Zerubbabel in the day the strength of the kingdoms is destroyed..."

> Dan. 2:44-- "And in the days of these kings shall the God of heaven set up a kingdom which shall never be destroyed."

2TG42: 31.3 — "Again, in verses 47 and 48 Christ draws a parallel between the Church a 'net'; the people he likens to 'fish,' and the purification to a separation, whereas in Matthew 25 He calls the purified Church the Kingdom of God, and the people He likens unto 'virgins,' and the cleansing He illustrates by a door which lets in the wise but keeps out the foolish. But His second parable of Matthew 25, the separation, we are told, is to be like a master who comes to reckon with his servants. Those who have done nothing good for the advancement of His kingdom (who have not traded with and increased His talents -- Matt. 25:27) are cast out, there to gnash their teeth in 'outer darkness.' (Matt. 25:30.) In His third parable the separation He likens to a shepherd who separates the goats from the sheep (sinners from the saints); the goats are condemned to die but the sheep are given

the right to the Kingdom."

TN1: 27.1 - "In the purification of the church, 'the angels shall...sever the wicked from among the just' (Matt. 13:49), but in the time of the 'Loud Cry,' they shall gather the just from among the wicked. So it is written: 'And after these things I saw another angel come down from heaven, having great power; and the earth was lightened with his glory.... And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, My people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues.' Rev. 18:1, 4."

TN1: 27.2 — "These two distinct separations, each at a different time, occur when (to recapitulate the facts specifically), in the time of the firstfruits, the wicked are taken from among the righteous in the church (net), and when, in the time of the second fruits, the righteous are taken from among the wicked <u>And such a</u> in Babylon. church -- pure in the absolute -- presupposes

TN1: 27.3 — "<u>Ezekiel's</u> prophecy revealing itself to be a message for the church ZECHARIAH FOUR today, the prophet, himself, must necessarily, then, represent the messengers who carry the message to the church at the time appointed. And in response to the Lord's command, 'Be not thou rebellious like that rebellious house: open thy mouth, and eat that I give thee,' Ezekiel's reply, 'Then did I eat it; and it was in my mouth as honey for sweetness' (Ezek. 2:8; 3:3), shows that the messengers obey the Lord and love His Word above everything else."

In the foregone references, we read that the pure church takes a pure message to the church, necessitating a pure ministry. Now, which is the pure church, and which church receives the pure message? Our answer can be found in--

2TG34: 24.3 - "As we are now living in the time of The Revelation, in the time of the unfolding of the prophecies which point to

the setting up of the Kingdom as well as to the second advent of Christ, the Church at this time, therefore, could not logically go by a name other than a name which would befit her present (advanced) phase of the gospel work."

2TG34: 24.4 — "Plainly, then, her name must express the truths she advocates: that is, the keeping of the commandments, the second advent of Christ, and also the restoration of the Davidian Kingdom according to prophecy. Hence the logical name that would represent her work from this time down to the time the Kingdom is set up, is to be Davidian Seventh-day Adventists, - a name that testifies of the Kingdom message, of keeping the commandments of which the seventh-day Sabbath is a part, and of the second

advent of Christ."

ventist denomination, wherein it therefore strictly confines its activities. As its work therewithin draws to a close, and the 'servants of our God' (Rev. 7:3) are sealed, its name will be changed (Isa. 56:5; 62:2; 65:15) and its purpose and its work will become all-embracing to the gospel (Matt. 17:11; Acts 3:21; Isa. 61:4-7). Then its Constitution and By-Laws as herein codified will become fully operative."

Here, we see that the work of the Davidian Seventh-day Adventists is solely for the Seventh-day Adventist denomination. Therefore, the pure church aforementioned on page 27 paragraph one can be none other than the Davidian Seventh-day Adventist Church (2TG34: **24.4**), which takes the pure message to the Seventh-day Adventist denomination. This pure church is also mentioned in--

1TG14: 22.2 — "...Here we see a candlestick (a church) all of gold, the finest of all candlesticks (no 'tares' in it). It constitutes the remnant (those that are left after the sinners are done away with) which indeed keep the commandments of God, and have the Testimony of Jesus Christ, the Spirit of Prophecy (Rev. 12:17; 19:10). ..."

We will now review each component of the symbolism--



THE TWO OLIVE TREES

Zech. 4:11-- "Then answered I, and said unto him, What [are] these two olive trees upon the right [side] of the candlestick and upon the left [side] thereof?"

Zech. 4:12-- "And I answered again, and said unto him, What [be these] two olive branches which through the two golden pipes empty the golden [oil] out of themselves?"

Zech. 4:13-- "And he answered me and said, Knowest thou not what these [be]? And I said, No, my Lord."

Zech. 4:14-- "Then said he, These [are] the two anointed ones, that stand by the Lord of the whole earth."

5SC1-5: 3.1.1 - "...the olive trees are symbolical of the Old and New Testament Scriptures ("The Great Controversy," p. 267)..."

TN6: 21.2 — "The fact that nothing but the Bible Itself did prophesy for the duration of the 1260 year period, -- the Dark Ages of religion, -- automatically shows that the two

'olive trees,' which the angel said are the Word of God (Zech. 4:6), are figurative of the Old and New Testament Scriptures' prophesying 'in sackcloth.' In other words, they permitted themselves in self-abasement to be tucked away and left unstudied, although they had power to devour 'their enemies,' and even 'to shut heaven, that it rain not."

1TG14: 19.1 — "Now study the illustration itself as you would study any cartoon. First of all, the trees represent the Word of God (the Bible -- both Old and New Testaments -- two <u>trees</u>)." (See also - SR2: 284.1)

THE GOLDEN OIL

Zech. 4:12-- "And I answered again, and said unto him, What [be these] two olive branches which through the two golden pipes empty the golden [oil] out of themselves?"

"God does not accept the most splendid service unless self is laid upon the altar, a living, consuming sacrifice. The root must be holy, else there can be no sound, healthy fruit, which alone is acceptable to God. The heart must be converted and consecrated. The motives must be right. The inner lamp must be supplied with the oil that flows from the messengers of heaven through the golden tubes into the golden bowl. The Lord's communication never comes to man in vain." - 7T 248.3

SR2: 210.3 — "It is an accepted fact by nearly all Bible students that 'oil' is used by the Scriptures as a symbol of the Holy Spirit, as in Psalms 45:7; Isaiah 61:1-3; Zechariah 4:12. 'Wine' is used as a symbol of the blood of Christ, and as the 'life is in the blood,' the wine denotes life eternal, found only in 'the Lamb of God which taketh away the sins of the world.' Said Jesus, 'The words that I speak unto you they are spirit and they are life' -'oil' and 'wine.' The words in the Bible are the 'Spirit' and the 'Life.'..."

TN6: 22.1 - "As the two olive trees stand for the Old and New Testament Scriptures, naturally the golden oil flowing from them represents 'the Word of the Lord' in the Christian dispensation, not as it comes directly from heaven, but as it comes from the Bible."

1TG14: 19.2 — "...spiritual oil (Bible Truth) so that it might give spiritual light all round about... oil (revealed Truth) ..."

ZECHARIAH FOUR

THE TWO GOLDEN PIPES

SR2: 285.1 — "...Therefore, the two golden pipes that empty the golden oil into the golden bowl are God's messengers of inspiration through whom present truth is revealed, and the only true interpreters of the Scriptures.

5SC1-5: 3.1.1 - "...the two golden pipes, which carry the golden oil from the trees to the bowl, are the only two mediums which God has employed since 1844 A.D. to interpret the Scriptures."

TN6: 23.4 — "The two pipes through which the oil is carried into the bowl, can represent only the channels (prophets) through whom the oil is transferred from the Bible into the bowl, in the period during which both olive trees (Old and New Testaments) live -- the Christian era."

TN6: 24.1 — "Let the reader take a searching look at the visual illustration on page 18, and he will see the utter impossibility of the candlestick's (the church membership's) and of the tubes' (ministers') themselves extracting oil directly from the olive trees. The interpretation of the Scriptures, therefore, being entrusted to the two pipes (prophets)

> in the Christian era, it shows that 'no prophecy of the Scripture is of any private interpretation,' but is of inspiration only."

ABN3: 32.1 — "...the two golden pipes, which carry the golden oil from the trees to the bowl, are symbolical of the Bible interpreters, the inspired messengers from God, for the symbolism immovably shows that they are the only ones whom Inspiration enables to draw the oil from the olive trees--to interpret the Scriptures. ..."

1TG14: 19.3 - "The two golden pipes, therefore, can be only a representation of the inspired channels which are capable to extract the oil (light of Truth) from the trees (from both Testaments) and store it in the bowl (books) for the tubes (ministers) to convey it to the candlestick (to the churches)."

Here we see that the two pipes represent those who were employed since 1844, being Sister E. G. White and Brother V. T. Houteff. There will be no other individual to interpret the prophecies of the Old and New

Testament Scriptures, save antitypical Elijah, of whom the Rod says--

GCS: 19.1 — "Joel's two chapters give us a most compact and vivid view of 'the great and dreadful day of the Lord.' From these alone we can clearly see what it is like. And as Elijah comes just before that day begins, he must necessarily be the one who is to interpret these prophecies of the day, and who consequently announces that the day is at hand."

GCS: 19.2 — "This surely confirms the conclusion that since Elijah is to herald the great day, he can therefore be the only one who will rightly interpret the prophecies of the day, which are still mysteries to Christendom, and even to our own Denomination! Indeed, to reiterate, it is for this very reason that the prophet is sent. He is to unroll the scroll to explain

what the day of the Lord is like, what the Lord will do then, and how we may survive His judgments. To re-emphasize the fact, let it be said again that being the last of the prophets Elijah is, therefore, the only one who

can open to our understanding all the prophecies of the Scriptures pertaining to the great and dreadful day of the Lord -- prophecies which heretofore have been only mysteries to all. Thus he is, as the Scriptures say, to blow the trumpet in Zion, and to sound an alarm in God's holy mountain, in the church."

ZECHARIAH FOUR

The False Teachings Concerning The Two Golden Pipes: Some teach that the two golden pipes represent all the messengers of God. Teachers of this erroneous doctrine have no supporting statement from the golden bowl, and there is no statement or Scripture in which the number two represents "all" or any number greater than two.

THE GOLDEN BOWL

SR2: 286.3 - "This golden candlestick is the most remarkable symbol in the Bible pertaining to the church of God. Its arrangement with complete number of lamps, bowl, tubes, and pipes, all of gold, with its two olive trees emptying themselves of the golden oil in the golden bowl, reveals that the last section of God's church, is to be the most glorious church in all ages. This 'continued communication' by the Holy Spirit to the church, represented by the olive branches emptying the 'Golden Oil out of themselves' into one Golden Bowl, and its complete set of Supply Tubes from the bowl to all its lamps, is to bring every part of the entire body in perfect harmony; a church without quile."

TN6: 23.3 — "Clearly, then, the bowl in which the golden oil is stored, symbolizes the storehouse of Present Truth -- the Word interpreted. The only 'storehouse' that contains inspired comments on both Tes-

> taments is the books of the Spirit of Prophecy. They, therefore, are the 'golden bowl...'

WHR: 37.2 - "Tragically, those who now fail to fill their vessels (Matt. 25:1-4) with this extra oil (the additional truth -- that of the judgment of the living) flowing from the golden bowl (Zech. 4) will

finally see their lamps flicker out forever like a gutted candle. O, in what consternation then will they search for the precious golden oil! And with what infinitely greater anxiety than they now search for gold and for prestige! But, alas, then like Esau, though they seek it 'carefully with tears,' they shall find 'no place of repentance': they purchase their oil too late. The door is closed when they reach it. And to their frantic knocking at it comes the terrifying reply, 'I never knew you.' Matt. 7:23. Then is the harvest of the first-fruits past, the fruits garnered in, and the tares shut out unto destruction, there in agony to wail and to gnash their teeth: 'The harvest is past, the summer is ended, and we are not saved' Jer. 8:20."

1TG14: 19.2 -"...the bowl in which the oil is deposited represents the container or the

store in which the compilations of Inspired Bible interpretations are stored..."

1TG14: 22.2 — "..the golden bowl (Spirit of Prophecy publications). ..."

THE CANDLESTICK

SR2: 283.5 — "...Therefore, the candlestick in Zechariah's vision denotes the church as a body."

SR2: 284.2 - "Thus we have a candlestick for each of the two sections of God's church while the Scriptures were being written. One candlestick and one olive tree to the Jewish, and one candlestick and one olive tree for the apostle's, and seven for the remaining

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ZECHARIAH FOUR

history of the church to the time of the separation of the tares from the wheat, or to the commencement of the harvest. Thus the candlestick (church) in Zechariah's vision is the tenth, denoting a universal church; depicting the living church that shall unite with all the saints since the world

began -- which will join with the church of the entire universe of God! This candlestick in Zechariah's vision is a glorious one, which in comparison, all others stand as 'nothing' -- in perfect harmony with the second temple, which in comparison the first stood as 'nothing.""

SR2: 290.1 - "It was previously explainedthat Zechariah's prophecy is applicable to the church in the time of the 'Loud Cry.' Thus it becomes present truth. We quote from Zechariah 12:8. 'In that day shall the Lord defend the inhabitants of Jerusalem; and he that is feeble among them at that day shall be as David; and the house of David shall be as God, as the angel of the Lord before them' -- before the great multitude of Revelation 7:9."

TN9: 61.5 - "The church of the Laodiceans, being the last of the seven churches, is the

last section of the Christian church in which the wheat and the tares are commingled. The overcomers, the marked ones, from it, those who hear the Rod, begin the eighth section of the church -- the one symbolized by the 'barn' (Matt. 13:30) and by the 'vessels' (Matt. 13:48), also by the 'golden candlestick' of Zechariah 4. Of her the Lord says: '...the Gentiles shall see thy righteousness, and all kings thy glory: and thou shalt be called by a new name, which the mouth of the Lord shall name. Thou shalt also be a crown of glory in the hand of the Lord, and a royal diadem in the hand of thy God.' Isa. 62:2, 3."

TN9: 64.1 - "And furthermore, as the eighth section of the church, the church eternal is of

> the seventh section, the church temporal just so the eighth beast, the post-millennial world, is of the seventh beast (Rev. 17:11), the pre-millennial world."

ABN1: 33.1 - "And just as David, the eighth son of Jesse, was not chosen until the succession of his seven brothers had one by one passed in review, so the 'house of David'

(Zech. 12:8; Testimonies, Vol. 5, p. 81), the church freed from 'the tares,' the eighth church in the New Testament succession, was not to come into being until the succession of seven had passed one by one. (See Tract No. 8, Mt. Sion at the Eleventh Hour.)"

ABN3: 32.1 — "Here it is seen that the candlestick, as interpreted by Revelation 1:20, is symbolical of the church membership; ..."

1TG14: 22.2 - "...Here we see a candlestick (a church) all of gold, the finest of all candlesticks (no 'tares' in it). It constitutes the remnant (those that are left after the sinners are done away with) which indeed keep the commandments of God, and have the Testimony of Jesus Christ, the Spirit of Prophecy (Rev. 12:17; 19:10). This fine candlestick is

fully trimmed and burning. ..."

Here we see the candlestick represents a pure church, being the eighth church, more particularly the church membership. Let us move on to--

THE SEVEN LAMPS

SR2: 285.2 — "If the candlestick represents the church as a body, then the seven lamps thereon must denote the sisterhood of churches scattered throughout the denomination. The Biblical number of completeness takes in the entire movement as a whole. This fact is also proven by the following quotation: 'When the anointed ones empty themselves through the golden pipes, the oil flows out of themselves into the golden bowl, to flow into the lamps, the churches.' - 'Testimonies to Ministers,' p. 337."

1TG14: 19.2 — "...seven lamps (the entire church membership) supplied with spiritual oil (Bible Truth) so that it might give spiritual light all round about, that the church might lighten the world with the revealed Word of God. ... the seven lamps (to the church)."



1TG14: 22.2 - "...the seven golden lamps (to the entire laity)."

Here, we see that the seven lamps represent the entire church membership, the sisterhood of churches, and the entire laity. Let us move on to--

THE SEVEN GOLDEN PIPES OR **TUBES**

SR2: 285.3 — "If the 'golden bowl' is that which contains the inspired interpretation of the Scriptures or the writings of the Spirit of Prophecy, and the lamps or churches are supplied with oil from the bowl through the seven golden tubes, then the ministry is represented by the tubes, whose duty is to feed the entire church with the inspired Word of God only. This fact also is proven by the 'Spirit of Prophecy,' as we read: 'The golden oil represents the Holy Spirit. With this oil God's ministers are to be constantly supplied, that they, in turn, may impart it to the church.' -- Id., p. 188. Note, the seven tubes (Ministry) draw the oil from the golden bowl, not direct from the olive trees (Scriptures)."

TN6: 21.3 – "And from these two trees (Testaments), as Zechariah saw, the golden oil runs through 'two golden pipes,' which empty themselves into the 'golden bowl.' Then from the bowl, the 'seven pipes,' or 'tubes,' in turn supply the golden 'candlesticks' with the 'golden oil.'"

TN6: 23.2 — "In Zechariah's vision, however, the ministers are represented, not by seven angels, but by seven 'tubes.' They get the oil from the bowl, and feed it to the candlestick."

> TN6: $24.3 - \dots$ the ministers (seven tubes), who alone are to pass on from the bowl the oil to the church (candlestick), that it might illumine with the light of life this dark and dying world of ours...."

1TG14: 22.2 - "...And the seven tubes (the entire ministry) convey from the golden bowl the golden oil..."

1TG14: 19.2 - "...And since the ministry's duty is to feed the church with spiritual food, the fact is that the seven tubes represent the ministry at work, taking the oil (revealed Truth) from the bowl to the seven lamps, the churches. Now the truth that in the illustration the tubes (the ministers) do not take the oil directly from the olive trees (the Bible), it positively indicates that the bowl in which the oil is deposited represents the container or the store in which the compilations of Inspired Bible interpretations are stored, and that from it, not from the olive trees, the ministers help themselves with oil and carry it to the seven lamps (to the church)."

Since the candlestick is a pure church with no tares in it,

it must be led by a pure ministry. The *Rod* says that the ministry is the first to be purified--

2TG31: 4.2 — "At this coming He is not to take His saints to the mansions above, but He is to purify the sons of Levi -- the ministry; He is to destroy the leaders of idolatry. Since the purity of His servants is first to be restored, the restoration, therefore, commences in the Church..."

Which church?

2TG34: 24.4 — "... the logical name that would represent her work from this time down to the time the Kingdom is set up, is to be Davidian Seventh-day Adventists, ..."

The General Conference could not be the ministry that will be purified when this prophecy is fulfilled, as it was rejected in 1888--

TN8: 49.1 - "Speaking to the S.D.A. leadership, the servant of the Lord says: 'You have no right to manage, unless you manage in God's order. Are you under the control of God? Do you see your responsibility to Him?... That these men should stand in a sacred place to be as the voice of God to the people, as we once believed the General Conference to be, -- that is past. What we want now is reorganization.' -- General Conference Bulletin, 34th Session, Vol. 4, Extra No. 1, April 3, 1901, p. 25, Cols. 1 and 2."

TN8: 49.2 — "This revelatory statement conclusively proves that after the historical Minneapolis meeting in 1888, when the leaders rejected both the message and the counsel which was given them (Testimonies To Ministers, p. 468) the Lord did not any longer regard the General Conference as His servants, just as He did not any longer regard Saul as king over Israel after he turned from the Lord's commands to him. now, having long since granted the popular demand to organize the General Conference, in fulfillment of the type, God warns that His forbearance is come to an end today just as it did then..."

Who are the new servants?

2TG43: 12.1 - "I say that if left in such an unhappy and unholy state the very elect would forever remain unclean and unsanctified -- deceived! And since the eleventh-hour servants, the Davidians, are the ones unto whom the message of this cleansing, 'the <u>Judgment of the Living,' is committed,</u> then those who on account of it are our enemies, those who are doing everything they can to keep the common people ignorant of the Truth and from coming in contact with It, are the very ones who are endeavoring to deceive 'the very elect,' if possible. Thank God that it is impossible."

Just as there exists a time gap between Saul's rejection and David's ascension to the throne, a similar time gap occurred between the rejection of the General Conference ministers and the succession of the Davidian ministry. The latter gap being between 1888 and 1931. For we read--

TN13: 44.3 — "1931 First Shepherd's Rod, adherent excommunicated from S.D.A. church. First S.D.A. medical doctor accepted message in July. First tithe remittance received September 9."

> TN4: 66.2 - "The instructions in The Shep herd's Rod, Vol. 51, 'Pay your honest tithe and offering to your church, and feel that 'IT IS' your Father's house,' came near

the close of 1930, before the leading brethren, as a denomination, had rejected the sealing message. Clearly, then, The Shepherd's Rod has faithfully discharged its duty in refusing to accept any tithes or offerings until after the books were scattered throughout the denomination, and after the brethren began bitterly to oppose the message. Now, though, since the opposition is no longer passive, but intensely active, and the proclamation of the message supremely urgent, the only course open is apparent. It will take an army of workers, including the tithes and offerings. to reach the people."

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TN4: 66.3 — "Consequently, as our leading brethren have inadvertently shown themselves unworthy stewards of God's 'storehouse' for the time of the 'Loud Cry of the Third Angel's Message,' He has transferred the 'candlestick' and is also calling for the tithes and offerings to be transferred into

'His storehouse' of Present Truth."

Upon the passing of Brother V. T. Houteff, the candlestick started to break apart, and now there are over 24 fragments of the Rod Movement. What says the Rod?

2TG11: 8.1 — "The net must represent the Truth, the message of the Kingdom. As it is cast into the sea, published and sent out, it is bound to catch good and bad. But when the net is drawn to shore, the bad are then cast out from among the good, and the good are put into vessels, into the Kingdom. Hence, merely because one is attracted by the mighty Truth, does not mean he is saved. His chance of staying forever with the Truth depends on his meeting the Lord's expectations of him."

The Davidian Church is the church with the Kingdom Truth; thus, the bad in it must be cast out. The Rod continues to say--

Matt. 13:30 -- "Let both grow together until the harvest: and in the time of harvest I will say to the reapers, Gather ye together first the tares, and bind them in bundles to burn them: but gather the wheat into My barn."

2TG42: 31.2 — "Here it is made clear that in this instance the wicked among the righteous are likened to tares, and the time of the cleansing itself, the Judgment, is likened to a 'harvest,' but that the cleansing itself is likened to a separation of wheat and tares."

2TG42: 31.3 — "Again, in verses 47 and 48 Christ draws a parallel between the Church a 'net'; the people he likens to 'fish,' and the purification to a separation, whereas in Matthew 25 He calls the purified Church the Kingdom of God, and the people He likens unto 'virgins,' and the cleansing He illustrates by a door which lets in the wise but keeps out the foolish. But His second parable of Matthew 25, the separation, we are told, is to be like a master who comes to reckon with his servants. Those who have done nothing good for the advancement of His kingdom (who have not traded with and increased His talents -- Matt. 25:27) are cast out, there to anash their teeth in 'outer darkness.' (Matt. 25:30.) In His third parable the separation He likens to a shepherd who separates the goats from the sheep (sinners from the saints); the goats are condemned to die but the sheep are given the right to the Kingdom."

1TG10: 26.2 — "...And the house of David -the kingdom that is to be set up, which is but the church purified, no sinners among them (Isa. 52:1), shall be as the angel of the Lord before the people."

This Candlestick represents the Kingdom in its Davidian period--



8SC1-12: 11.1.1 — "Thus, the Lord's voice is crying unto the city, the church, that He shall shortly purify it by removing all but the few narrow-way travelers who have sighed and cried for the abominations therein, and have consequently received the seal of God. He is, in other words, warning the church that the harvest is come and that He is about to cast out the bad fish and transfer the good fish into the vessels (Matt. 13:47)--the Kingdom in its Davidian period (Hos. 3:4, 5)."

TN4: 37.5 — "And though the typical firstborn lost their priestly inheritance to the Levites, yet in the restitution of all things, in the final Davidian Period (Acts 15:16), this office will be restored to the antitypical firstborn, the firstfruits of the harvest (Rev. 14:4), for they are 'the servants of our God.' Rev. 7:3. This restoration, therefore, is to follow their Absolute Reformation, Resulting in Perfect Safety."

To whom is the leadership of the restitution of all things assigned?

Acts 3:19-21-- "Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord. And He shall send Jesus Christ, which before was ZECHARIAH FOUR preached unto you: Whom the heaven must receive until the times of restitution of all things, which God hath spoken by the mouth of all His holy prophets since the world began."

2TG31: 3.2 — "Here we are told that the heavens must receive the Lord, not forever, but until the times 'of restitution of all things.' He is, therefore, at the time of restitution to return to earth."

2TG31: 3.3 — "Shall this returning be unexpected? or shall the Lord first send someone to prepare His way? And if someone is to precede His coming, who will it be? - 'And he answered and told them, Elias verily cometh first, and restoreth all things.' Mark 9:12. The Lord, moreover, through the prophet Malachi declares:"

Mal. 3:1; 4:5-- "Behold, I will send My mes-

senger, and he shall prepare the way before Me: and the Lord, Whom ye seek, shall suddenly come to His temple, even the messenger of the covenant, whom ye delight in: behold, he shall come, saith the Lord of hosts.... Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the Lord."

2TG31: 4.1 — "Here the Scriptures point out that someone in the spirit and power of Elijah the prophet is first to appear, and will not only prepare the way, but will also restore all things. Plainly, the message of Elijah shall restore all things in the great and dreadful day of the Lord, the day of restitution, the day the Lord comes to His temple, the Church. The spirit of Elijah was a spirit against idolatry, and his power was a power to destroy those who led in idolatry, and to bring about purity."

Do not be deceived by the false doctrine that the Message only will restore all things, hear what the Rod says--

> JL9: 1.5 - "There are two main points to note in these quotations: (1) that the message and messenger here mentioned are the very last; (2) that they are to restore all things, (3)

that there is danger for some to make fools of themselves by daring to tell him how to teach his message -- assuming to take God's place!"

Before we deal with "The Testimony of Jesus" illustrated, we must expose the enemy's effort to destroy the truth pertaining to the living Spirit of prophecy in the church when the prophecy is being fulfilled. In the pictorial interpretation of chapter four of Zechariah's vision, published by Brother V. T. Houteff, only six of the seven tubes access the oil from over the top of the bowl. The one tube labeled "The Testimony of Jesus" does not access the oil from over the top of the Bowl. Let us observe that he is extracting oil, for his lamp is lit like the others. The question to be answered is how he is getting the oil. The answer is found in verse six: "Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the LORD of hosts." However, an uninspired new modeler, the founder of the original Salem Association, decided that the one tube not going over the top was a mistake by Brother Houteff.

Brother uninspired-new-modeler vested himself with the authority to correct Brother Houteff's inspiration and depicted seven tubes going over the top as he interpreted Zechariah's vision, as seen below.



This false pictorial interpretation of Zechariah's vision is used by most Davidians worldwide. For many years, the Salem Association was the only group distributing the large teachers' charts and only his corrected version was distributed. Thus, Davidia, not knowing the chart was altered, purchased the man's dung and ate it up, thinking it was the Rod. When the new modeling of the chart was pointed out to the leaders of Davidia, they acted like the Pharisees, ashamed that they had been deceived for so many years and knew it not. So they upheld the altered chart and agreed that Brother Houteff made a mistake, fulfilling part of the prophecy in TM: 475, which says—"... you do not interpret the Scriptures in the proper way. Let me tell you how to teach your message."

Both the teachers who accept the altered chart and those who reject it, declare that the one tube not going over the top of the Bowl to access the oil was not labeled, and the arrow next to said tube is labeling the Bowl for a second time. Notwithstanding, the largest label in the illustration is that of the Bowl, placed on the Bowl itself. Declaring that the Bowl is labeled twice, Satan again deceives the false teachers and gains a temporary victory in rejecting the one who is to come to prepare the way for the Lord's second advent.

The teachings vary among the various groups regarding the symbolization as a whole. Some believe that the seven pipes or tubes represent the 144,000, and the symbolization depicts the church in the loud cry, taking the Message to the world. In contrast, others believe that the system illustrated in **Zechariah's fourth chap**ter was in operation during Brother V. T. Houteff's life and is operating in certain groups now.

It is ridiculous to believe that Inspiration neglected to label what is now undeniably the most controversial aspect of the vision but felt compelled to emphasize the element with the most prominent label twice, even though it is the central focus of the illustration. Observe that the arrows do not label the Olive trees. Likewise, an arrow does not label the Bowl. Why arrow and the non-arrow labeling? The components not labeled by arrows are the major source of the oil. Whereas the non-arrow labeled components are conduits of the oil.

The one tube not going over the top of the Bowl to extract its oil represents the one minister who will accomplish what a multitude of ministers have failed to accomplish. He also has the Testimony of Jesus Christ and is the living Spirit of Prophecy. This one minister or shepherd cannot be Brother Houteff, for he is one of the two pipes, and both are dead. Let the *Rod* speak--

5SC1-5: 3.1.1 - ...the two golden pipes, which carry the golden oil from the trees to the bowl, are the only two mediums which God has employed since 1844 A.D. to interpret the Scriptures."

2TG2: 23.2 — "God does not forsake His flock. He tenderly calls them 'My flock,' and reassures them that He is their God. He will. without fail set one shepherd to accomplish what a multitude of shepherds have failed to do. Now is your opportunity to feast on 'meat in due season,' at the hand of God's chosen shepherd, or starve on husks at the hand of a multitude of shepherds."

Do not be fooled by the adverb "now" thinking it applies to the time the statement was published, for the prophecy interpreted by the statement was not completely fulfilled at that time, but rather, it applies to the time the prophecy is being completely fulfilled and the time of complete fulfillment is pointed out in a previous statement in the same study--

2TG2: 17.2 — "In the days of this antitypical David God gathers His flock from all the countries where they have been scattered, and brings them into their own land. God will no longer leave them in the mountains and the hills of the Gentiles. 'Then shall the children of Judah and the children of Israel be gathered together, and appoint themselves one head, and they shall come up out of the land: for great shall be the day of Jezreel. Afterward shall the children of Israel return, and seek the Lord their God, and David their

king; and shall fear the Lord and His goodness in the latter days.' Hos. 1:11; 3:5."

Note that "in the days" being in the lifetime of this antitypical David, God gathers His people from all the countries and brings them into their own land, the Kingdom, which clearly shows that this antitypical David will be translated. An earlier statement in the same study shows that the fulfillment of the prophecy was not before or at the time of the publication, but in the future--

2TG2: 14.3 — "The self-centered shepherds against whom the prophet is told to write, are to be replaced by one shepherd, David. When this takes place God's people will then have but one shepherd. This, of course, cannot be Christ Himself, for Inspiration never calls Him David, but rather It calls Him the Son of David. Since God's people have always had, and still do have many shepherds, the truth stands out as clear as crystal that the David of verses 23 and 24 is yet to come, and that the shepherds whom Inspiration addresses are in particular those whom David is to succeed."

When we consider that the last phase of the gospel Message of the judgment of the living will cause the devil to have his waterloo, we can see why he is trying his best to distort the truth of the antitypical prophet of the prophets. How thankful we ought to be that it is Christ who controls the Truth, not the devil and his agents.

The *Rod* tells us that the candlestick represents a pure church--

1TG14: 22.2 — "...Here we see a candlestick (a church) all of gold, the finest of all candlesticks (no 'tares' in it). It constitutes the remnant (those that are left after the sinners are done away with) which indeed keep the commandments of God, and have the Testimony of Jesus Christ, the Spirit of Prophecy (Rev. 12:17; 19:10). This fine candlestick is fully trimmed and burning..."

You have already read that the symbolism shows how the pure church will operate to keep the new sisterhood of Davidian Seventh-day Adventist churches lit and the world out of complete darkness. To reiterate, we read again--

1TG14: 20.1 - "The symbolism, therefore,

points out the system which Heaven has ordained for dispensing the Word of the Lord to His church..."

TN6: 23.3 — "...The symbolism definitely points out that from them the ministers must get the light-producing truth with which to supply the church..."

Which church?

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2TG34: 24.4 — "Plainly, then, her name must express the truths she advocates: that is, the keeping of the commandments, the second advent of Christ, and also the restoration of the Davidian Kingdom according to prophecy. Hence the logical name that would represent her work from this time down to the time the Kingdom is set up, is to be Davidian Seventh-day Adventists, -- a name that testifies of the Kingdom message, of keeping the commandments of which the seventh-day Sabbath is a part, and of the second advent of Christ."

> A pure church necessitates a pure ministry. Therefore, the seven pipes ministry in this vision must be those pointed out in--

LDSDA: 3.2 - "The name, Davidian, deriving from the name of the king of Ancient Israel, accrues to this Association by reason of its following aspects: First, it is dedicated to the work of announc-

ing and bringing forth the restoration (as predicted in Hosea 1:11; 3:5) of David's kingdom in antitype, upon the throne of which Christ, 'the son of David,' is to sit. Second, it purports itself to be the first of the first fruits of the living, the vanguard from among the present-day descendants of those Jews who composed the Early Christian Church. With the emergence of this vanguard and its army, the first fruits, from which are elected the 12,000 out of each of the twelve tribes of Jacob, 'the 144,000' (Rev. 14:1; 7:2-8) who stand on Mount Zion with the Lamb (Rev. 14:1; 7:2-8), the reign of antitypical David begins."

This statement tells us that it is the first fruits of the living that has two groups of people, the vanguard and its army. In addition, we are told that the "144,000," the first part of the woman's seed, are elected from the vanguard and its army, the first fruits. Since the first of the first fruits of the living, the vanguard will be the present-day descendants of those Jews, the two tribes kingdom, who composed the Early Christian Church; their total can be only 24,000 since only 12,000 from each tribe will be saved in the first fruits harvest.

We, therefore, conclude that the 24,000 present-day descendants of those Jews who composed the Early Christian Church, the Davidian Seventh-day Adventists, after the first of the first fruits harvest, are the seven pipes of Zechariah's vision of the pure Church, all of gold. The following statements also support this conclusion:

TN1: 27.2 — "These two distinct separations, each at a different time, occur when (to recapitulate the facts specifically), in the time of the firstfruits, the wicked are taken from among the righteous in the church (net), and when, in the time of the second fruits, the righteous are taken from among the wicked in Babylon. And such a church -- pure in the absolute -- pre-

Pure Message."

supposes an absolutely

TN1: 27.3 — "Ezekiel's prophecy revealing itself to be a message for the church today, the prophet, himself, must necessarily, then, represent the messengers who carry the message to the church at the time appointed. ..."

Note that a pure church is required for the pure Message, which will be going to the Ninth-hour Church. When is the appointed time? The Rod says--

ZECHARIAH FOUR

TN1: 36.4 — "When considered in the light of the four main facts so far established, these questions are virtually self-answering: (1) the Lord comes to earth in this chariot; (2) from it He commands Ezekiel to go speak to His people; (3) Ezekiel did not bear the message to the people of his day; (4) he will bear it to the people at the commencement of the 'Loud Cry."

This paragraph is widely misinterpreted by the false teachers, who teach that item (1) is the Lord coming in vision to Ezekiel, the priest, at the river Chebar; and items (2) and (3) also refer to Ezekiel, the priest, but item (4) refers to Brother Houteff when he resurrects and in the kingdom directs the work. This conclusion is derived from the uninspired understanding of the very next paragraph, which states that Brother Houteff delivered his message--

TN1: 37.1 - "Thus it is seen that when the time comes that the church has reached the condition described by the Lord (Ezek. 3-9), the mystery of the vision is to be revealed, and the message carried to the church. And that the church has already reached this time and condition is conclusively evidenced by the threefold fact that the first part of this 'most startling revelation' (dilated herein), was published in December, 1930, in a 255-page book entitled The Shepherd's Rod, Vol. 1; that the second part was published in the month of September, 1932, in a 304-page book entitled The Shepherd's Rod, Vol. 2; and that the third part -- the series of tracts (of which this is the first) which since 1933 aggregates to date some 898 pages -- comprises Volume 3."

> Inspiration here is addressing two different times for fulfillment of the prophecy as Christ did when He was asked of Elijah's coming; let us read--

Matt. 17:10-13-- "And his disciples asked him, saying, Why then say the scribes that Elias must first come? And Jesus answered and said unto them, Elias truly shall first come, and restore all things. But


I say unto you, That Elias is come already, and they knew him not, but have done unto him whatsoever they listed. Likewise shall also the Son of man suffer of them. Then the disciples understood that he spake unto them of John the Baptist."

Notice that Christ first spoke of the antitypical fulfillment of the prophecy, being the future from His time when all things shall be restored. Immediately thereafter, He mentioned the present fulfillment. In like manner, the *Rod* in **TN1: 37.1** first addresses the antitypical fulfillment of the prophecy, for Ezekiel chapters 3 to 9 are parenthesized, and Ezekiel 9 is yet to be fulfilled. Then, it mentions Brother Houteff's deliverance (present) of partial revelations of the Message, evidenced by the various parts of the Message at different intervals stated in the paragraph. We must not fail to mention that since the 1941 statement in Tract No. 1, the Message underwent several revisions and additions, including revisions to several of the **Numbered Tracts**, and the addition of the **Answerers** and the **Timely Greetings**

Volumes. Then, in the last two years of his life, Brother Houteff revised **Timely Greetings Volume One** in its entirety, portions of Volume Two, and the 1950 General Conference Special. Then, a few months after the revisions, he went to sleep. He did not deliver the completed Message to the people of his time.

Getting back to items 1, 2, 3, and 4 in TN1: 36.4, we can now correctly understand these items through the eyes of inspiration—1) the Lord coming to the earth in 1930 to reveal the *ROD Message* to Brother Houteff; 2) the Lord commanding Brother Houteff to deliver each portion of the Message as he received it at various times, which he published and taught, save the last revelations received in 1953 and 1954 just before his death on February 5, 1955; 3) Brother Houteff, after receiving the last portion of the Message, did not teach or explain any of it to the people of his day; 4) the Davidians who are left standing after the work of the six men with slaughter

weapons is completed will bear the Message to the Ninth-hour Church at the time appointed, at the commencement of the "Loud Cry." We all know that the loud cry has not yet begun. Therefore, it behooves us to let the **ROD** tell us when it will begin--



TN1: 20.1 - "Since the purification, or the sealing, came at the commencement of the 'Loud Cry,' as we have already seen, the 144,000 are therefore the 'first-fruits' -- the first to be sealed; whereas those who are sealed after the purification of the church, are the second fruits, of whom John (after having seen the 144,000 sealed) says: 'After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands.' Rev. 7:9."

As Davidians, we should heed the warning given to us

SR2: 288.3 — "...Not until our minds have been cleared from all these false theories can we comprehend the truth. In other words the Laodiceans must confess that the charge against them is true - 'wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked;' and by acceptance of the truth they would anoint their eyes 'with eyesalve;' for it is the 'true witness speaking, and his Word must be correct.' Find your explanations 'in the Bowl,' and you will have no trouble in knowing the truth, or of avoiding the ever ready trap of deception. Thus the difficulty in knowing the difference between truth and error is eliminated."

1TG3: 9.2 — "If John could not see exactly what the horses looked like, then how could he see that all the fish in the sea died (Rev. 8:9)? And

with such a self-exalting precedent for studying the Scriptures as the kind the General Conference has set up, how can anyone be sure that any of the prophets saw anything right? Do you not realize that such foolish and twisted interpretations of the Scriptures are Satanic attempts to undermine men's confidence in the prophets and

of Christ's ability to correctly reveal and portray Truth to His servants? Consider how damaging the charge against Inspiration, how soul-destroying, and blasphemous against the Holy Ghost Who leads into all Truth! and how repulsive it must be to Christ, especially for coming from those who pretend to serve Him! This alone ought to be sufficient to show that..." Davidia "...is blind and naked and in need of everything. For the sake of your life and for the lives of others, do not support such doctrines of devils. They are anything but Truth, anything but signs of the Spirit of Prophecy at work... And if you still wonder why God permitted the errors to creep into the church, the answer is: So that by their fostering and propagating them He may at a time such as this expose the workers of iniquity and prove to the laity that His church is now as badly overrun by the Devil as was the Jewish church at Christ's time, thus to awaken the honest ones and to set them free from their Laodicean self-deception, and thus from the overflowing scourge (Isa. 28:13-15)."



"Why not make your chief interest His business? Why not the Kingdom of God and His righteousness, so that 'all these things be added unto you'? Why work to feed yourself? Why not work for God and let Him feed and clothe you? He is far more capable of providing for you than you will ever be. Why not let Him take charge of your work, of your home, of your body? 
RWANDA GROUP



Translation of the Rod Literature

The Division has been working on the translation of the Rod literature since August 2022. The members who are mainly involved in this task are Sis. Therese Fernando, Bro. Reginold Fernando and Bro. Priyantha Warnakulasooriya.

Bro. Manesha Fernando is responsible for the adjustments and editing of the translated documents.



Prayer Meetings and Sacred Music

The members have daily prayer meetings via online calls where they pray for each other and for the cause of Present Truth. For Sabbath openings, they have a program which includes prayers, hymns and Spirit of Prophecy studies. In addition to these studies, Sis. Therese Fernando conducts studies for the members during the week as well.

There are a number of singers and instrumentalists, some of whom are active participants in Eastern and Western Hemisphere prayer meetings.

New Funding Program and Control Room

A fund has been initiated so that members could be assisted if sudden financial needs arise. This initiative was taken mainly due to the fact that the education of some of the members' children is aided by the SDA church, and, due to the growing opposition against them, they could lose this aid; at which time, by God's grace, the brethren would be able to provide the needed support.

A new project was planned and started, which is to build a new Control Room in Sri Lanka. The main reason behind it is to have a place to control all the events which are being hosted in Sri Lanka and for other church-related activities as well. Currently, a bulk of the work has been finished in the construction of the room. However, due to the ongoing economic crisis in Sri Lanka, the prices of every item have largely increased. As a result, the remaining work in the room has been temporarily suspended. We trust that God will provide for its completion at His appointed time.

Opposition from Mother Church

The Mother church has always been heavily opposed to the Present Truth and their opposition has been increasing. A few months ago, some SDA leaders visited Bro. Reginold supposedly to discuss the message but they were very biased and had ulterior motives. Bro. Reginold has been falsely accused of imposing his teachings on church members.

Recently, a meeting was held between the President of the Sri Lankan SDA churches, several church boards and leaders, SDA members and Bro. Reginold. Their main aim was to refute the message and disfellowship our brother, but their efforts were unsuccessful. By God's grace, he successfully defended the truth and it is special to note that the church members were against the idea of disfellowshipping him. We thank God for His leading.

Meeting for the First Time

Most of our current members joined and started to learn the Present Truth 2019-2020. It was the same year the Present Truth was brought to Sri Lanka through Sis. Therese. Due to Covid-19 restrictions, learning and discussions among the members were done on online platforms like Viber and Zoom and the members had not met in person since then. There were cookery programs held in Lusaka, Kafue and Monze where the members were educated to prepare healthful meals.









Two seminars were conducted in Tanzania, in the region of Musoma and Mwanza. We currently have thirteen prospective members in Tanzania.



MELODY IN THE VALLEY

As we read through sacred history, we find that some of the greatest heights of spiritual attainment have been marked with song. The Israelites, together with Moses, right after their miraculous deliverance from the Egyptian host which was consumed by the depths of the Red Sea - which God had parted a moment before for the Israelites' escape – sounded their praise in melody:

Ex. 15:2-- "The LORD is my strength and song, and he is become my salvation: he is my God, and I will prepare him an habitation; my father's God, and I will exalt him."

In Judges Chapter 5 is recorded the song that the prophetess Deborah and Barak sang following their marvelous victory from God over the Canaanite King Jabin:

Judg. 5:2, 3-- "Praise ye the LORD for the avenging of Israel, when the people willingly offered themselves. Hear, O ye kings; give ear, O ye princes; I, even I, will sing unto the LORD; I will sing praise to the LORD God of Israel."

In the book of 2 Chronicles, we read of how the Israelites defeated an entire army with song:

2 Chron. 20:21, 22-- "And when he had consulted with the people, he appointed singers unto the LORD, and that should praise the beauty of holiness, as they went out before the army, and to say, Praise the LORD; for his mercy [endureth] forever. And when they began to sing and to praise, the LORD set ambushments against the children of Ammon, Moab, and mount Seir, which were come against Judah; and they were smitten."

These are but a few of the many instances in Scripture that bear out the fact that music is indeed a divine element, an integral component of the Heavenly Kingdom. Our God is a musical God. The Bible says that He joys over His people with singing (Zephaniah 3:17). As beings created in the image of the Master Musician, we are very responsive to music. We are moved, and our minds can be deeply impressed by it. Inspiration has revealed its value

in these words:

"The value of song as a means of education should never be lost sight of. Let there be singing in the home, of songs that are sweet and pure, and there will be fewer words of censure and more of cheerfulness and hope and joy. Let there be singing in the school, and the pupils will be drawn closer to God, to their teachers, and to one another. As a part of religious service, singing is as much an act of worship as is prayer. Indeed, many a song is prayer." - Education, pp. 167, 168.

But should music only be associated with joy and victory? Inspiration makes it clear that it ties in with worship. If we are to maintain an attitude of worship at all times, then indeed, music can mark every step of our pilgrim journey, even as we tread through the darkest valleys. In moments of despair when all seems to be engulfed in gloom, making melody in our hearts to the Lord can break those shackles of darkness just as easily as it loosed the prison chains of Paul and Silas. Some of the most beautiful words of praise and surrender to God were penned in sorrowful times. So, we ought to blend a note of holy cheer with any circumstance in life, even the most trying. Our Divine Pattern left us an example in all things including the right use of music:

"When Christ was a child like these children here, He was tempted to sin, but He did not yield to temptation. As He grew older He was tempted, but the songs His mother had taught Him to sing came into His mind, and He would lift His voice in praise. And before His companions were aware of it, they would be singing with Him. God wants us to use every facility which Heaven has provided for resisting the enemy." - Manuscript 65, 1901.

"With a song, Jesus in His earthly life met temptation. Often when sharp, stinging words were spoken, often when the atmosphere about Him was heavy with gloom, with

dissatisfaction, distrust, or oppressive fear, was heard His song of faith and holy cheer." - Education, p. 166.

We are well aware of the power of "It is Written" over temptation. It is the sword that never fails to vanquish the efforts of the enemy. But how often do we meet temptation with song? The idea might not even occur to many of us. We may feel that it is not at all the opportune moment to sing whilst in the midst of an intense spiritual battle. But our Lord demonstrated that it is very effective even then. Songs that are rooted in the Word of God are like a tuneful prayer that invites the atmosphere of Heaven around us.

Not only can music lighten our own burdens, but its blessing can radiate to those around us as well, bringing comfort to their troubled hearts. Those that came in contact with Christ were not only blessed by his benevolent words and deeds but also by His singing:

"Christ descended to poverty that He might teach how closely in our daily life we may walk with God. He took human nature that He might be able to sympathize with all hearts. He was capable of sympathizing with all. He could engage in toil, bear His part in sustaining the family in their necessity, become accustomed to weariness, and yet show no impatience. His spirit was never so full of worldly cares as to leave no time nor thought for heavenly things. He often held communion with heaven in song. The men of Nazareth often heard His voice raised in prayer and thanksgiving to God; and those who associated with Him, who often complained of their weariness, were cheered by the sweet melody that fell from His lips." - The Review and Herald, October 24, 1899.

"The early morning often found Him in some secluded place, meditating, searching the Scriptures, or in prayer. With the voice of singing He welcomed the morning light. With songs of thanksgiving, He cheered His hours of labor and brought heaven's gladness to the

toilworn and disheartened." - The Ministry of Healing, p. 52.

Much like every other gift, our voices are also a gift from God that we are expected to cultivate for His glory and also for the uplifting and edification of one another. You are to be "Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord." Ephesians 5:19.

As Present Truth believers, awaiting a better home, even a Kingdom, our journey is no easy one. We experience every sense of our Master's words "The narrow way." Yet we can praise God for the many tokens of His love and for every weapon that He has furnished us with to engage in this warfare, one of them being music. Inspiration says:

"Let praise and thanksgiving be expressed in song. When tempted, instead of giving utterance to our feelings, let us by faith lift up a song of thanksgiving to God. Song is a weapon that we can always use against discouragement. As we thus open the heart to the sunlight of the Saviour's presence, we shall have ... His blessing." - The Ministry of Healing, p. 254.

David was an individual greatly bestowed with the gift of music. In trial and in triumph he sang to the Lord, and the words of the Spirit that flowed through his pen have been upon the lips of the faithful down through the ages. That same Spirit thrives among us today and we, as Davidians, who have been blessed with an abundance of light on God's Holy Word, have every reason to sing a song of praise. The Butter and Honey being the substance of our music, let us grow in appreciation of what we can accomplish through our songs for our own spiritual journey and the upbuilding of God's Kingdom. Let us sing a tune of faith and hope along our journey towards the Kingdom where we shall at last stand on Mount Zion and, in unison, lift our voices in melodious praise to our God and the Lamb.

He is waiting to place upon their heads the crown of life, and hear their happy voices join in ascribing honor and glory and majesty to God and the Lamb in the song of victory that shall echo and re-echo throughout the courts of heaven. -The Review and Herald, August 19, 26, 1884 ..." - FE 91.1.

FIDELITY TO GOD IS OUR MOTTO

2TG1: 12.1 - "The Lord abhors indifference and disloyalty in a time of crisis in His work. The whole universe is watching with inexpressible interest the closing scenes of the great controversy between good and evil. The people of God are nearing the borders of the eternal world; what can be of more importance to them than that they be loyal to the God of heaven? All through the ages, God has had moral heroes; and He has them now, - those who, like Joseph and Elijah and Daniel, are not ashamed to acknowledge themselves His peculiar people. His special blessing accompanies the labors of men of action; men who will not be swerved from the right line of duty, but who with divine energy will inquire, "Who is on the Lord's side?" men who will not stop merely with the inquiry, but who will demand that those who choose to identify themselves with the people

of God shall step forward and reveal unmistakably their allegiance to the King of kings and Lord of lords. Such men make their wills and plans subordinate to the law of God. For love of Him, they count not their lives dear unto themselves. Their work is to catch the light from the Word, and let it shine forth to the world in clear, steady rays. Fidelity to God is their motto.' - Prophets and Kings, p. 148."

Fidelity is defined by faithfulness to a person, cause, or belief, demonstrated by continuing loyalty and support. The Lord needs in this time of the end, men and women, boys and girls, who are not ashamed of Him and His Word, to work for Him in His vineyard. While there are many who claim to be people of God, their actions prove them to be otherwise. As Jesus came and showed us the way, we should prove our loyalty to the law of God, not fearing for our lives nor what men may do or

say to us. And what better way to gain this courageous and fervent love for our Maker than through prayer! We are admonished in the following passages:

"When Jesus was upon the earth, He taught His disciples how to pray. He directed them to present their daily needs before God, and to cast all their care upon Him. And the assurance He gave them that their petitions should be heard, is assurance also to us." - SC 93.3.

"Jesus Himself, while He dwelt among men, was often in prayer. Our Saviour identified Himself with our needs and weakness, in that He became a suppliant, a petitioner, seeking from His Father fresh supplies of strength, that He might come forth braced for duty and trial. He is our example in all things. He is a brother in our infirmities, 'in all points tempted like as we are;' but as the sinless one His nature recoiled from evil; He endured struggles and torture of soul in a world of sin. His humanity made prayer a necessity and a privilege. He found comfort and joy in communion with His Father. And if the Saviour of men, the Son of God, felt the need of prayer, how much more should feeble, sinful mortals feel the necessity of fervent, constant prayer." - SC 93.4.

Like Christ, we should make prayer a necessity in our lives for we can never endure this race on our own. It is a grave mistake to ever think we can become like Christ without the much needed communication with God. Matthew 26:41 says: "Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak." Here we are warned to keep watch, for there will always be a willingness in spirit to serve the Lord, but without continuous prayer our desire will never become an unwavering loyalty to God. The Lord waits to bestow His blessings upon us, all we need to do is ask. As we ask for His help let us be true learners and doers of the Word, as did the men in the school of God:

"In the school of God he (Enoch)... learned to walk with God (Gen. 5:22)... to this very day he holds the championship in aviation

- 2TG25: 3.3... Noah's boat, you know, was large enough and strong enough to house and carry a pair or more of every living creature on Earth, including all necessary provisions for man and beast to last over a year! - 2TG25: 3.4... Joseph became the world's greatest economist and banker - 2TG25: 6.4... Moses... learned how to become the world's greatest emancipator-general, author, ruler, educator, lawmaker and prophet. - 2TG25: 7.1... In the school of God the student is quaranteed to become the best in whatever line he undertakes. And my advice to you is that whether you be grass, or tree, so to speak, choose to be the best of its kind. Such you can be if you will to do so, for there are no failures in the school of God. You can become the best herdsman or the best king, the best teacher or the best preacher, the best banker, or the best of whatever it be." - 2TG25: 8.3.

Though this world is not our own, and we are just passing by, the Lord desires that we shall be the best at whatever we undertake so that He may show forth His loving-kindness not only to us, but also to those around us. It should be our privilege to take heed to the words of the Lord, for only then will the Lord manifest His blessings in our lives. Let us not wait for the crowd to seek the Lord or wait for the time in our lives that may be most "convenient" to us, for there never will come that time; "... The true followers of Christ ... do not wait for truth to become popular. Being convinced of their duty, they deliberately accept the cross." -TN7: 65:1.

2TG21: 2.2 - "Cares, riches, pleasures, all are used by Satan in playing the game of life for the human soul. The warning is given, 'Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him...' He who reads the hearts of men as an open book says, 'Take heed to yourselves, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting and drunkenness and cares of this life."

2TG21: 2.3 - "We are to pray for to overcome the love of the world and to remember that Satan is playing the game of life for the souls of God's people; to be given grace to work and

pray as never before; to overcome the wiles of the Devil; to know that he is no foe to be trifled with, and that Jesus is the Captain Who never lost a battle; that if we enlist His help He will see us through."

All things considered, may we ever be loyal to our God and His laws, so that we may be the Vanguard that He has brought us here to be. Oh what a privilege it is to always be in communion with Heaven, hungering for the bread of life and thirsting for His ever cleansing blood! SINCERE REPENTANCE ACCEPTED BY GOD

Jer. 26:13-- "Therefore, now amend your ways and your doings, and obey the voice of the LORD your God; and the LORD will repent him of the evil that he hath pronounced against you."

"Although as sinners we are under the condemnation of the law, yet Christ, by His obedience rendered to the law, claims for the repentant soul the merit of His own Righteousness. In order to obtain the Righteousness of Christ, it is necessary for the sinner to know what that repentance is which works a radical change of mind and spirit and action. The work of transformation must begin in the heart, and manifest its power through every faculty of the being; but human beings are not capable of originating such a repentance as this, and can experience it alone through Christ, who ascended up on high, led captivity captive, and gave gifts unto humanity." - BLJ 382.2.

Who is desirous of becoming truly repentant? What must they do?

"They must come to Jesus, just as they are, without delay. They must believe that the word of Christ is true, and, believing the promise, ask, that they may receive. When sincere desire prompts people to pray, they will not pray in vain. The Lord will fulfill His

word and will give the Holy Spirit to lead to repentance toward God and faith toward our Lord Jesus Christ. They will pray and watch, and put away their sins, making manifest their sincerity by the vigor of their endeavor to obey the commandments of God. With prayer they will mingle faith, and not only believe in but obey the precepts of the law. They will announce themselves as on Christ's side of the question. They will renounce all habits and associations that tend to draw the heart from God." - BLJ 382.3.

"All sinners who would become children of God must receive the truth that repentance and forgiveness are to be obtained through nothing less than the atonement of Christ. Assured of this, they must put forth an effort in harmony with the work done for them, and with unwearied entreaty they must supplicate the throne of grace, that the renovating power of God may come into their souls." - BLJ 382.4.

"Christ pardons none but the penitent, but whom He pardons He first makes penitent. The provision made is complete, and the eternal righteousness of Christ is placed to the account of every believing soul. The costly, spotless robe, woven in the loom of heaven, has been provided for the repenting, believing sinner, and everyone may say: 'I will

greatly rejoice in the Lord, my soul shall be joyful in my God; for he hath clothed me with the garments of salvation, he hath covered me with the robe of righteousness' (Isaiah 61:10).— Selected Messages, book 1, pp. 393, 394." - BLJ 382.5.

"Though David had fallen, the Lord lifted him up. He was now more fully in harmony with God and in sympathy with his fellow men than before he fell. In the joy of his release he sang: 'I acknowledged my sin unto thee, and mine iniquity have I not hid. I said, I will confess my transgressions unto the Lord; and thou forgavest the iniquity of my sin. . . . Thou art my hiding place; thou shalt preserve me from trouble; thou shalt compass me about with songs of deliverance' (Psalm 32:5-7)." - BLJ 383.2.

"Many have murmured at what they called God's injustice in sparing David, whose quilt was so great, after having rejected Saul for what appear to them to be far less flagrant sins. But David humbled himself and confessed his sin, while Saul despised reproof and hardened his heart in impenitence." -BLJ 383.3.

"This passage in David's history is full of significance to the repenting sinner. It is one of the most forcible illustrations given us of the struggles and temptations of humanity, and of genuine repentance toward God and faith in our Lord Jesus Christ. Through all the ages it has proved a source of encouragement to souls that, having fallen into sin, were struggling under the burden of their quilt. Thousands of the children of God, who have been betrayed into sin, when ready to give up to despair have remembered how David's sincere repentance and confession were accepted by God, notwithstanding he suffered for his transgression; and they also have taken courage to repent and try again to walk in the way of God's commandments." - BLI 383.4.

"Whoever under the reproof of God will humble the soul with confession and repentance, as did David, may be sure that there is hope for him or her. Whoever will in faith accept God's promises will find pardon. The Lord will never cast away one truly repentant soul. He has given this promise: 'Let him take hold of my strength, that he may make peace with me; and he shall make peace with me' (Isaiah 27:5). 'Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto the Lord, and he will have mercy upon him; and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon' (Isaiah 55:7).-Patriarchs and Prophets, p. 726." - BLJ 383.5.

SR1: 200.1 - "The people of God must see their wrongs, and arouse to zealous repentance, and a putting away of those sins which have brought them into such a deplorable condition of poverty, blindness, wretchedness, and fearful deception."

SR1: 245.3 - "Those who receive this message are to arise from their spiritual feebleness to true godly repentance..."

SR1: 252.1 - "The people of God must see their wrongs, and arouse to zealous repentance, and a putting away of those sins which have brought them into such a deplorable condition of poverty, blindness, wretchedness, and fearful deception. I was shown that the pointed testimony must live in the church. This alone will answer to the message to the Laodiceans. Wrongs must be reproved, sin must be called sin, and iniquity must be met promptly and decidedly, and put away from us as a people.' Volume 3, pages 258-260."

SR2: 46.1 - "The Lord is not slack concerning His Promise, as some men count slackness; but is long suffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.' (2 Peter 3:9.)"

3SC11-12: 9.1.5 - "In ancient times God spoke to men by the mouth of prophets and apostles. In these days He speaks to them by Testimonies of His Spirit. There was never a time when God instructed His People more earnestly than He instructs them now

concerning His will, and the course that He would have them pursue. But will they profit by His teachings? Will they receive His reproofs and heed His warnings? God will accept of no partial obedience; He will sanction no compromise with self.' -Testimonies for the Church, Vol. 4, p. 148."

3SC11-12: 9.2.1 - "Yet He defers His chastisement, to give them one more opportunity to repent and avert the retribution for their sin. Through His chosen prophet, He now sends them a clear and positive, warning, and lays before them the only course by which they can escape the punishment which they deserve. This is a full repentance of their sin, and a turning from the evil of their ways;" - Testimonies for the Church, Vol. 4, pp. 165, 166."

3SC11-12: 9.2.2 - "A sin-hating God calls upon those who profess to keep His law to depart from all iniquity. Neglect to repent and obey His word will bring as serious consequences upon God's people today as did the same sin upon ancient Israel. There is a limit beyond which He will no longer delay His judgments. The desolation of Jerusalem stands as a solemn warning before the eyes of modern Israel, that the corrections given through His chosen instruments cannot be disregarded with impunity.' - Testimonies for the Church, Vol. 4, pp. 166, 167."

OUR ROLE AS MOTHERS

Greetings and peace be upon you all. My name is Sis. Esther Mwaba, from Zambia Division. I am blessed to serve the Lord as a mother of two lambs, Sis. Kasuba (almost four years) and Bro. Daniel (one year, eleven months), a wife to Bro. Denis Mwaba, and the Secretary of the Executive Council. The Lord called me to His vineyard under the most convicting of circumstances. Now what remains is my incessant joy and peace and unquantifiable sense of gratitude to my Redeemer and Friend Jesus the Christ. I count it a privilege and am humbled and delighted to fulfill my God-ordained role as a homemaker and nurturer to my little lambs. I have come to depend on the Lord in this most sacred duty, for His strength is made manifest in my weakness. The Lord is merciful and kind, a present help to all who seek Him. Please allow me to share something that has been of help to me as a mother aiming to raise Godly and Kingdom-bound children.

Filling them with useful knowledge

The Bible and Inspiration have made it clear concerning the training and raising of children

in a home. The Onus lies squarely on the parents, especially the mother. God has designed the family here to be like the family above. Every aspect of order and system is for our own good and is connected to our salvation and happiness even in this life.

"The position of a woman in her family is more sacred than that of the king upon his throne. Her great work is to make her life an example such as she would wish her children to copy. And by precept as well as example, she is to store their minds with useful knowledge, and lead them to self-sacrificing labor for the good of others. The great stimulus to the toiling, burdened mother should be that every child who is trained aright, and who has the inward adorning, the ornament of a meek and quiet spirit, will shine in the courts of the Lord." - CE 178.3.

One of the key themes when it comes to the training of children is to teach them the scripture. More precisely, to train the children to commit to memory the passages of scripture. A question may be asked, why should we do this?

Why?

- The Bible instructs us to do so. Just as it was in the past when the Lord wanted to shield His people from the evil influences of idolatry. Deuteronomy 11:18, 19-- "Therefore shall ye lay up these my words in your heart and in your soul, and bind them for a sign upon your hand, that they may be as frontlets between your eyes. And ye shall teach them your children, speaking of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, when thou liest down, and when thou risest up."
- Gives them the correct bearing in life. "The Bible should be the child's first textbook. From this book, parents are to give wise instruction. The Word of God is to be made the rule of the life. ..." - CG 41.1.
- Having God's Word rooted in the heart will help to fight temptation. This is true of children's minds too. We have an example from Christ as we see Him use the word. "That is how Jesus met the enemy in the wilderness of temptation, not with arguments of His own to match those of Satan, but with a plain, 'It is written." - WR, September 15, 1909 par. 6.
- "The Word of God is a channel of communication with the living God. He who feeds upon the Word will become fruitful in all good works. He . . . will be the discoverer of rich mines of truth which he must work to find the hidden treasure. When [he is] surrounded with temptations, the Holy Spirit will bring to his mind the very words with which to meet the temptation at the very moment when they are most needed, and he can use them effectually." - FLB 8.4.
- To have a knowledge of God. "God designed the Bible to be a lesson-book to all mankind, in childhood, youth, and manhood, and to be studied through all time. He gave His Word to men as a revelation of Himself. ... It is the medium of communication between God and man." - FLB 10.5.
- Parents may use Scripture when requiring

- obedience from their children. Correction and disciplining of children is not easy/effective when it is founded on emotions or want of control. Children may be reasoned with after prayer and pointed to God's Word. Children will only obey when they know what they should do and what they should not do. Knowing the scriptures by memory helps them understand what is expected of them. "The mother must keep her mind refreshed and stored with the promises and blessings of God's Word, and also the forbidden things, that when her children do wrong, she may present as a reproof the words of God, and show them how they are grieving the Spirit of God." - CG 41.2.
- "When children err, parents should take time to read to them tenderly from the Word of God such admonitions as are particularly applicable to their case. When they are tried, tempted, or discouraged, cite them to its precious words of comfort, and gently lead them to put their trust in Jesus. Thus the young mind may be directed to that which is pure and ennobling..." - RH, June 13, 1882 par. 13.
- The mind is the best storehouse for truth. "The time will come when many will be deprived of the written Word. But if this Word is printed in the memory, no one can take it from us." - LDE 67.5.
- "Study the Word of God. Commit its precious promises to memory so that, when we shall be deprived of our Bibles, we may still be in possession of the Word of God." - LDE 67.6.

Practical ways to train our children to commit Scripture to memory

- "Pray for Heavenly Wisdom. Parents should reflect and pray earnestly to God for wisdom and divine aid to properly train their children, that they may develop characters that God will approve..." - CG 189.2.
- Know God's Word as a parent, especially a mother.
- ∇i Start early. Speak God's Word to them and the songs of Bethlehem from the womb and in babyhood. Allow the children to take part

in the family devotion by reciting verses or by acting out Bible scenarios to help them imprint them in their minds.

- Use our lesson book (nature). "Children should be encouraged to search out in nature the objects that illustrate Bible teachings, and to trace in the Bible the similitudes drawn from nature. They should search out, both in nature and in Holy Writ, every object representing Christ, and those also that He employed in illustrating truth. Thus, may they learn to see Him in tree and vine, in lily and rose, in sun and star. They may learn to hear His voice in the song of birds, in the sighing of the trees, in the rolling thunder, and in the music of the sea. And every object in nature will repeat to them His precious lessons." - CG
- ∇ Simplify things. "The parents are to teach their children lessons from the Bible, making them so simple that they can readily be understood." - CG 43.3. Use simple language, start with short verses, and increase as they get more established. Use signs, and gestures, play out some portions of Bible stories, songs and objects they can see and touch.
- Be patient. A restful, gentle and quiet man-

ner will achieve much good.

Repeat. The human mind is accustomed to habit. Children learn well when lessons are repeated. Do not grow weary in well doing.

"When Samuel shall receive the crown of glory, he will wave it in honor before the throne and gladly acknowledge that the faithful lessons of his mother, through the merits of Christ, have crowned him with immortal glory." -AH 536.2.

Occasions to complain, get overwhelmed or discouraged will be there. But like the women of old (such as Jochebed, Hannah, Elizabeth, and Mary,) who triumphed by the grace of God, we too may obtain grace to raise children whom God shall delight in.

"The work of wise parents will never be appreciated by the world, but when the judgment shall sit and the books shall be opened, their work will appear as God views it and will be rewarded before men and angels...." - AH 536.3.

Asleep in Jesus!! Soon to Rise.

November 2023 was indeed a sad month for the Davidian Seventh-day Adventist Church.

The first of the two deaths, which occurred in the month of November 2023, was the sleeping of our beloved

Sister Alethia C. Blount.



Our Beloved Sister went to sleep in the Lord on the 9th day of November. Sister Alethia was born on December 12, 1937, sharing the same birthday as the first Treasurer of the Davidian Movement, Sister Florence Floretta Charboneau, born on December 12, 1874. Sister Florence was the first Treasurer of Mount Carmel Center in 1935. Likewise, Sister Alethia was the first Treasurer when the Davidian Movement returned to Mount Carmel in 1989 after thirty-two years of absence.

Sister Alethia grew up in Reidsville, Georgia, and in 1956, relocated to Boston, Massachusetts, where she raised five children. In the early 1960s, Sister Alethia joined the Berea Seventh-day Adventist Church in Dorchester, Massachusetts, where she served in many capacities, including: Sabbath School Superintendent, Sabbath School Teacher, Usher, Board Member, President

of the Northeastern Federation of Ushers, Personal Ministries Leader, and Choir Member. In the latter part of the 1980s, Sister Alethia received a copy of one of the *Rod* Tracts and, along with other members of the Berea church, began studying the *Shepherd's Rod* Message. She accepted the Truths therein and became a member of the Montaindale Association. Shortly after joining the Mountain Dale group, the location Truth was presented to the new Boston group, as they were called. This group accepted the truth, declaring that Waco was the permanent location for the proclamation of the sealing Message. The group took a trip from Boston to Waco, Texas, and saw the land built up and owned by the Gentiles. The Printshop that Brother Houteff built was still standing and was then owned by the Presbyterian church. Mount Carmel's Administrative building, called Building No. 8 by the original residents of Mount Carmel, was and still is owned by the Vanguard Preparatory School. The Boston Group, with Sister Alethia in the van, prayed and claimed repossession of Mount Carmel. After Mountain Dale's Biblical Research Committee declared that Waco was not the permanent location for the proclamation of the sealing Message and that the Association must remain in Mountain Dale, New York, the Boston Group organized themselves into an Association and followed "it is written" and began preparation to relocate to Waco, Texas.

Sister Alethia, the late Brother Carl, and the late Sister Joyce Huggins returned to Waco a little while after their trip to rent one of the homes on Mount Carmel in preparation for the answer to the prayer for reclaiming a portion of Mount Carmel. To their astonishment, the Lord opened a way for them to purchase a large home without acquiring a new mortgage. Sister Alethia was the first to relocate to Waco. She came to Waco in the true spirit of a pioneer, not even a bed, with only very few kitchen necessities, and braved it. Sister Alethia continued to be an active member in the Waco Association, which swelled when the brethren they left behind in 1988 joined them in 1991.

In early 2009, Sister Alethia began studying the truth concerning the purification of the Davidian Movement, which purported to be the first of the first fruits. She later embraced all the truths taught by Wave-sheaf Ministries and became a member and the Assistant Treasurer in the early years. Sister Alethia remained a faithful member of the Davidian Seventh-day Adventist Church, formerly Wave-sheaf Ministries, until she was laid to rest in the sleep of death. She was outspoken and deliberate and loved to serve the Lord, primarily when serving others.

We look forward to seeing her in the special resurrection of Dan. 12:2.

The last death of November 2023 was the going-to-sleep of

Sister Gloria Ann Nalls.

Sister Gloria went to sleep in death just before the Sabbath on Preparation Day, November 24, 2023. She went to sleep thirty days after being dedicated to serve as an Executive Council Member of the Davidian Seventh-day Adventist Association.



Sister Gloria was born on June 6, 1955, to the late L.T. and Emma Pearl Arnold, one of eight children. She will always be in the memory of her husband of thirtysix years Dannie Lee Nalls, her daughters LaCinna Arnold and Alisca Nalls, her granddaughter Tiara Arnold, and the members of the Eleventh-hour Church.

She grew up in a First-day Church and later joined the Seventh-day Adventist Church, where she became a student of the Word, always ready to learn and share. She was a very orderly, organized, and observant person. She received the Rod Message and took a firm hold on it. For several years, she was a member of the Salem Association, then left around 2018. In February 2020, she heard the Truths advocated by the Eleventh-hour Church and immediately realized the Truth was residing in said church. She became an active member of the Eleventh-hour Church, serving in various roles therein; her last call was to serve as a member of the Executive Council. As Providence would have it, she was asked to attend the Executive Council meetings two weeks before her appointed time. Her keen, observant ability proved to be a tremendous help


