



THE SOLEMN ASSEMBLY **IS FOR THE** ANTITYPICAL SHOWDOWN

MEDITATION THOUGHT:

ABN5: 29.4 - And now the only safe and sane procedure is to read closely every page of the solemn message contained in The Shepherd's Rod publications. Let not a line escape your attention. Study every word carefully and prayerfully. Be earnest and diligent in your perusal of Truth, and "prove all things; hold fast that which is good." 1 Thess. 5:21.

ABN3: 41.3 - Let us remember always to observe the inviolable rule that an interpretation of one inspired statement must harmonize with all other related statements.

2TG41: 6.5 - Does not the Denomination's perverted trend in finding Heaven-revealed Truth prove to you that God is left out of consideration, that in His place are put those who are supposed to be His servants? What else can it be if man is consulted when the Spirit of God should be? Are we not told by the Scriptures that the Spirit Himself is to lead us individually into all Truth? that we are not to make flesh our arm by having someone else decide for us what is Truth and what is error? Are we not denying the Spirit and our connection with Heaven when we take a substitute? And still worse is it to go for advice to one who is already against that which you expect him to approve or disapprove. If God can teach the cattle individually to seek water in the lower lands, not on the top of the mountains and hills, and to search for a place of warmth where the wind does not strike, then why can He not personally show us what is Truth and what is error?

2TG41: 7.1 - Were the founders of the church directed into Truth by the counsel of the priests and rabbis, or by the Spirit of God in their hearts? Are we not individually told:

"Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world. Hereby know ye the Spirit of God: Every Spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God." 1 John 4:1, 2. "Quench not the Spirit. Despise not prophesyings. Prove all things; hold fast that which is good." 1 Thess. 5:19-21.

2TG41: 8.2 - "Those who allow prejudice to bar the mind against the reception of truth can not receive the divine enlightenment. Yet, when a view of Scripture is presented, many do not ask, Is it true, -- in harmony with God's word? but, By whom is it advocated? and unless it comes through the very channel that pleases them, they do not accept it. So thoroughly satisfied are they with their own ideas, that they will not examine the Scripture evidence, with a desire to learn, but refuse to be interested, merely because of their prejudices.

2TG41: 8.3 - "The Lord often works where we least expect Him; He surprises us by revealing His power through instruments of His own choice, while He passes by the men to whom we have looked as those through whom light should come. God desires us to receive the truth upon its own merits, -- because it is truth." -- Testimonies To Ministers, pp. 105, 106.

2TG41: 8.4 - The world has never seen a more religious group, nor a more praying and pious people than were the priests, scribes, and Pharisees in Christ's day. Yet they were the very ones who protested against Christ's teachings, who spread prejudice and confusion among the people and who kept them in darkness! Yes, they deceived a whole nation. Finally, if the Jewish Sanhedrin was not to be trusted at Christ's first advent, then how do we know that the Christian's Sanhedrin at Christ's second advent is to be unquestionably correct? It was the Sanhedrins of the middle ages and down to this day that have fought against any Divinely led Reformation...

THE PREDICTION OF THE **UPCOMING SHOWDOWN**

2TG41: 7.2 - Moreover, Amos by the eye of Inspiration looked down through the centuries, deep into the Christian era, and declared:

Amos 1:2-- The Lord will roar from Zion, and utter His voice from Jerusalem; and the habitations of the shepherds shall mourn, and the top of Carmel shall wither.

2TG41: 7.3 - This scripture, you see, reflects the tragedy which took place on the top of Carmel in the days of Elijah. Here we are given the hint that there is to be another show-down between the prophet of God and the prophets of Baal. ...

For there to be a **show-down**, emphasis on the word show, which means to be seen, the people must assemble to see the **show-down**, and it will be

A SOLEMN ASSEMBLY.

Why solemn? Let us consider the meanings of the word solemn--

- Religiously serious; piously grave; devout; marked by reverence to God; as solemn prayer; the solemn duties of the sanctuary.
- Affectioning with seriousness; impressing or adapted to impress seriousness, gravity or reverence; sober; serious. There reigned a solemn silence over all. To 'swage with solemn touches troubled thoughts.
- Grave; serious; or affectedly grave; as a solemn face.
- Sacred; enjoined by religion; or attended with a serious appeal to God; as a solemn oath.

Let us now hear the meanings of the word assembly--

- A congregation or religious society convened.
- A convocation, convention or council of ministers and ruling elders delegated from each presbytery; as the General Assembly of Scotland or of the United States.
- A company or collection of individuals, in the same place; usually for the same purpose.

Let us confirm through the lens of the first **showdown** that a solemn assembly is required--

1 Kings 18:17-20-- And it came to pass, when Ahab saw Elijah, that Ahab said unto him, [Art] thou he that troubleth Israel? 18 And he answered, I have not troubled Israel; but thou, and thy father's house, in that ye have forsaken the commandments of the LORD, and thou hast followed Baalim. 19 Now therefore send, [and] gather to me all Israel unto mount Carmel, and the prophets of Baal four hundred and fifty, and the prophets of the groves four hundred, which eat at Jezebel's table. 20 So Ahab sent unto all the children of Israel, and gathered the prophets together unto mount Carmel.

These Scriptures show that an assembly preceded the first showdown. Note carefully that Elijah commanded King Ahab to call the assembly as though he were the monarch and Ahab the subject. Thus it will be for the soon coming solemn assembly, antitypical Elijah will command the leaders of the various Davidian habitations to assemble their inhabitants. Let us hear what the first pipe in the Golden Bowl has to say on the assembly on ancient Mt. Carmel--

Standing before Ahab, Elijah demanded that all Israel be assembled to meet him and the prophets of Baal and Ashtoreth on Mount Carmel. "Send," he commanded, "and gather to me all Israel unto Mount Carmel, and the prophets of Baal four hundred and fifty, and the prophets of the groves four hundred, which eat at Jezebel's table." - PK 143.1

The command was issued by one who seemed to stand in the very presence of J_H_V_H [blessed be the name of the Lord]; and Ahab obeyed at once, as if the prophet were monarch, and the king a subject. Swift messengers were sent throughout the kingdom with the summons

to meet Elijah and the prophets of Baal and Ashtoreth. In every town and village the people prepared to assemble at the appointed time. As they journeyed toward the place, the hearts of many were filled with strange forebodings. Something unusual was about to happen; else why this summons to gather at Carmel? What new calamity was about to fall upon the people and the land? - PK 143.2

Before the drought, Mount Carmel had been a place of beauty, its streams fed from neverfailing springs, and its fertile slopes covered with fair flowers and flourishing groves. But now its beauty languished under a withering curse. The altars erected to the worship of Baal and Ashtoreth stood now in leafless groves. On the summit of one of the highest ridges, in sharp contrast with these was the broken-down altar of J_H_V_H [blessed be the name of the Lord]. - PK 144.1

Carmel overlooked a wide expanse of country; its heights were visible from many parts of the kingdom of Israel. At the foot of the mount there were vantage points from which could be seen much of what took place above. God had been signally dishonored by the idolatrous worship carried on under cover of its wooded slopes; and Elijah chose this elevation as the most conspicuous place for the display of God's power and for the vindication of the honor of His name. - PK 144.2

Early on the morning of the day appointed, the hosts of apostate Israel, in eager expectancy, gather near the top of the mountain. Jezebel's prophets march up in imposing array. In regal pomp the king appears and takes his position at the head of the priests, and the idolaters shout his welcome. But there is apprehension in the hearts of the priests as they remember that at the word of the prophet the land of Israel for three years and a half has been destitute of dew and rain. Some fearful crisis is at hand, they feel sure. The gods in whom they have trusted have been unable to prove Elijah a false prophet. To their frantic cries, their prayers, their tears, their humiliation, their revolting ceremonies, their costly and ceaseless sacrifices, the objects of their

worship have been strangely indifferent. - PK 144.3

Facing King Ahab and the false prophets, and surrounded by the assembled hosts of Israel, Elijah stands, the only one who has appeared to vindicate the honor of J H V H [blessed be the name of the Lord]. He whom the whole kingdom has charged with its weight of woe is now before them, apparently defenseless in the presence of the monarch of Israel, the prophets of Baal, the men of war, and the surrounding thousands. But Elijah is not alone. Above and around him are the protecting hosts of heaven, angels that excel in strength. - PK 147.1

THE PREDICTED SHOWDOWN

Let us read the Scripture and the entire paragraph of the prediction of the other **showdown**--

Amos 1:2-- The Lord will roar from Zion, and utter His voice from Jerusalem; and the habitations of the shepherds shall mourn, and the top of Carmel shall wither.

2TG41: 7.3 - This scripture, you see, reflects the tragedy which took place on the top of Carmel in the days of Elijah. Here we are given the hint that there is to be another show-down between the prophet of God and the prophets of Baal. The prophets of Baal in our day even boast that they are not inspired, that what they teach and preach is what they themselves discovered by deep study and research! They even sneer at those who claim to be inspired of the Lord! They seem to think that God has forsaken the earth; that He cares not to send His Spirit as in former time; that men are now so wise that what the Spirit can do for them, they themselves can do even better! The truth is, though, that if there ever was a need for inspired interpreters of the Scriptures, it is today while many winds of doctrines are blowing from all directions, bringing in confusion, dissension, and disaster everywhere. No one sees eye to eye!

In **Amos 1:2**, the Lord is on earth when the **showdown** occurs; how else could He "roar from Zion and utter His voice from Jerusalem"? Note that the prophet of God must be at the **showdown**, and the place for the showdown, antitypical Mount Carmel, must be in existence. Therefore, the prophet of God must be in the Church before the showdown to call the solemn assembly. Since the **showdown** is between God's prophet and the prophets of Baal, it proves that the showdown is before the purification of the church while the false teachers are still in the Church. Let us hear the Rod concerning the prophet of God in the church before the dreadful purification--

A PROPHET IN THE CHURCH **BEFORE THE PURIFICATION**

2TG24: 23.1 - Here is the Bible's own answer, which says that there is to be a people who will have the Testimony of Jesus Christ at the time the earth swallows up the flood, the hypocrites. And since this incident is yet future, it shows that there is to be a prophet in the Church, for the Bible's own interpretation of "the Testimony of Jesus Christ," is "the Spirit of Prophecy" (Rev. 19:10). The first part of chapter 19 you will note explains that the Spirit of Prophecy is brought to them by a man, a "fellow servant," and that those who receive him feel like worshiping him, but he directs them to worship God, not a man.

2TG24: 23.2 - The remnant that are left, the saints who were not swallowed by the Dragon's flood as the earth opened her mouth, you note have the "testimony of Jesus Christ," the living Spirit of Prophecy active in their midst. The Church therefore will not sleep forever, the true people of God will awake to their poverty, they will profit at this rousing call, but the Dragon's flood will fill the bowels of the earth.

2TG24: 23.3 - Let now no one deceive himself by thinking that the Bible Itself is the active Spirit of Prophecy. Let us be God's real people, logical thinkers, not bait hunters. The Bible, you know, without the human channel, is as inactive as though It were but ink and paper. Moreover, the Spirit, too, apart from man, is also inactive:

2TG24: 24.1 - He, too, works through the human agent. Hence, without an inspired interpreter the concealed prophecies and the Spirit that unfolds them are inactive. Moreover, how could it be said of one particular group

<u>having the Spirit of Prophecy, when all the</u> sects in Christendom have the Bible?

These four contiguous statements confirm that there is to be a prophet in the Church when the purification of the church takes place, and since Brother V. T. Houteff is in the grave and will not be resurrected until after the purification of the church, during the "time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation" (Dan. 12:1), as we will read in a few paragraphs ahead, he cannot be the last prophet to the church. Sadly, these statements are twisted by the enemies of the Present Truth, who say that the Message is now the active Spirit of Prophecy. If the Bible "without the human channel is inactive as though It were but ink and paper," pray tell me how the active living Spirit of Prophecy could be the *Rod Message* by itself. In speaking of the restoration of all things, which begins with the purification of the Church, the *Rod* says both the Message and the prophet will restore all things: let us read--

THE PROPHET AND THE MESSAGE RESTORE ALL THINGS

JL9: 1.4 - "Prophecy must be fulfilled. The Lord says: 'Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the Lord.' Somebody is to come in the spirit and power of Elijah, and when he appears, men may say: 'You are too earnest, you do not interpret the Scriptures in the proper way. Let me tell you how to teach your message." --"Testimonies to Ministers," pp. 475, 476.

JL9: 1.5 - There are two main points to note in these quotations: (1) that the message and messenger here mentioned are the very last; (2) that they are to restore all things, (3) that there is danger for some to make fools of themselves by daring to tell him how to teach his message -- assuming to take God's place!

Note carefully that TM 475, 476 also applies to the last prophet, Elijah, of "the great and dreadful day of the Lord," and more so than the first application, for in the first application, the General Conference ministers never tried to tell Elijah the author of the **SRod Message** how to teach his Message: they simply rejected it. However, the Davidian opposers claim to know Elijah's message better than he does since they are the ones saying, "Let me tell you how to teach your message." This proves that the Message was available to the opposers before antitypical Elijah of "the great and dreadful day of the Lord" began teaching it. We know this to be true because the SROD *Message* has been available in its entirety since 1954.

In addition, **JL9: 1.5** says, "They are to restore all things," the prophet and the Message. Do not allow the crafty agents of the enemy disguised as teachers to beguile you into believing that the Message alone will "restore all things;" ask them if it is so, why are they teaching. The only reason for claiming the Message alone without the prophet will "restore all things" is to reject the prophet before his announcement.

Let us hear the Truth on the time of Brother Houteff and Sister White's resurrection--

THE TIME OF THE SPECIAL RESURRECTION

Dan. 12:1-3-- And at that time shall Michael stand up, the great Prince which standeth for the children of thy people: and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation even to that same time: and at that time thy people shall be delivered, every one that shall be found written in the book. ²And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt. 3 And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever.

2TG7: 14.1 - In these three verses several things clearly stand out: (1) Only those whose names are written in the books are delivered; there are therefore no "foolish" ones among them; (2) Those who are resurrected, however, are mixed, both foolish and wise come up; (3) The statement, "and they that be wise [implying that some be foolish] shall shine as the brightness of the firmament" indicates that these "wise" ones are from among the raised; (4) That if the wise are from among the resurrected and turn many to righteousness, then they must be resurrected in probationary time, in time of salvation.

2TG7: 14.2 - "Your work, my work, will not cease with this life. For a little while we may rest in the grave, but, when the call comes, we shall, in the kingdom of God, take up our work

once more." -- Testimonies, Vol. 7, pg. 17.

SR2: 235.2 - Why were the first paid last, and the last first? Answer. -- The pay God's servants receive is eternal life, and is characterized by the penny. Therefore, those who are granted the assurance of a never ending life first, are those who were hired last, and according to the parable, it was the company called at the eleventh hour. They are those who are marked or sealed by the man with the writer's inkhorn of Ezekiel 9, or as John calls him, the angel with the seal of God; and he sealed, or marked, 144,000. (See Rev. 7.) This glorious company is the first who are granted the assurance of never tasting death. (See "The Shepherd's Rod," Vol. 1, pp. 22-24.) Thus they are paid first but those who were called early in the morning (Israel after the flesh) are to be resurrected (the righteous) when Christ comes in the clouds, at which time they shall be given immortality. "So that the last shall be first, and the first, last." For this reason, those who were sealed and saved by the Third Angel's Message since 1844, are resurrected in the special resurrection before Christ comes. (See Dan. 12:2; "Early Writings," p. 285.)

2TG7: 11.2 - Do you now realize that not only the time of trouble is at the door, but even this special resurrection? Do you actually see that in the time of trouble, while the living saints are being delivered these dead who rise "to everlasting life," are also delivered from their graves? Do you realize that this time of trouble is in "the great and dreadful day of the Lord," the day which the promised prophet Elijah announces? Do you actually know that he is to turn the hearts of the fathers and of the children toward each other? lest the Lord smite "the earth with a curse." Mal. 4:5, 6. Do you see that the prophet appears in a day he can restore all things, everything that was lost through sin, even the Kingdom? Do you know that the resurrection of Daniel 12 is not the same as the resurrection of 1 Thessalonians and of Revelation 20:5?

Since Brother Houteff resurrects after the purification of the Church, in the "time of trouble, such as never was

since there was a nation" (Dan. 12:1), he cannot be the prophet who is to be in the church when the earth opens her mouth and swallows up the flood, who announces when "the great and dreadful day of the Lord" will begin, who "turns the hearts of the fathers to their children," who calls the solemn assembly for the coming showdown on Mt. Carmel and conducts the showdown. Therefore, the prophet who will be in the Church at the time of its purification and will call the solemn assembly must be "the Elijah of the great and dreadful day of the Lord" (GCS: 31.4), not Elijah of 1930 to 1955. We must now rightly divide the Word of Truth for the complete typology of the mission of Elijah, and to do this we will begin with the first and last parts of the mission in the typology--

THE MISSION OF ELIJAH IN **ANTITYPE**

Mal. 3:1-3-- Behold, I will send my messenger, and he shall prepare the way before me: and the Lord, whom ye seek, shall suddenly come to his temple, even the messenger of the covenant, whom ye delight in: behold, he shall come, saith the LORD of hosts. ²But who may abide the day of his coming? and who shall stand when he appeareth? for he [is] like a refiner's fire, and like fullers' soap: 3And he shall sit [as] a refiner and purifier of silver: and he shall purify the sons of Levi, and purge them as gold and silver, that they may offer unto the LORD an offering in righteousness.

Mal. 4:5,6-- Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD: 6And he shall turn the heart of the fathers to the children, and the heart of the children to their fathers, lest I come and smite the earth with a curse.

We have heard the prophecy. Now let us hear the fulfillment, the same being the antitype--

Matt. 3:1-4-- In those days came John the Baptist, preaching in the wilderness of Judaea, ²And saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand. For this is he that was spoken of by the prophet Esaias, saying, The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make his paths straight. ⁴And the same John had his raiment of camel's hair, and a leathern girdle about his loins; and his

meat was locusts and wild honey.

Mark 1:6,7-- And John was clothed with camel's hair, and with a girdle of a skin about his loins; and he did eat locusts and wild honey; 7And preached, saying, There cometh one mightier than I after me, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to stoop down and unloose.

Matt. 3:5,6,11,12-- Then went out to him Jerusalem, and all Judaea, and all the region round about Jordan, 6And were baptized of him in Jordan, confessing their sins. 11 I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and [with] fire: 12 Whose fan [is] in his hand, and he will thoroughly purge his floor, and gather his wheat into the garner; but he will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire.

Mark 1:4,8-- John did baptize in the wilderness, and preach the baptism of repentance for the remission of sins. 8I indeed have baptized you with water: but he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost.

As John prepared the people to meet their Messiah, Christ showed up to be baptized of him--

Mark 1:9-- And it came to pass in those days, that Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee, and was baptized of John in Jordan.

Matt. 3:13-17-- Then cometh Jesus from Galilee to Jordan unto John, to be baptized of him. ¹⁴But John forbad him, saying, I have need to be baptized of thee, and comest thou to me? ¹⁵And Jesus answering said unto him, Suffer [it to be so] now: for thus it becometh us to fulfil all righteousness. Then he suffered him. 16 And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him: 17 And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

Mark 6:16-29-- But when Herod heard [thereof], he said, It is John, whom I behead-

ed: he is risen from the dead. 17For Herod himself had sent forth and laid hold upon John, and bound him in prison for Herodias' sake, his brother Philip's wife: for he had married her. 18 For John had said unto Herod, It is not lawful for thee to have thy brother's wife. 19Therefore Herodias had a quarrel against him, and would have killed him; but she could not: 20 For Herod feared John, knowing that he was a just man and an holy, and observed him; and when he heard him, he did many things, and heard him gladly. ²¹And when a convenient day was come, that Herod on his birthday made a supper to his lords, high captains, and chief [estates] of

Galilee; 22 And when the daughter of the said Herodias came in. and danced. and pleased Herod and them that sat with him, the king said unto the damsel, Ask of me whatsoever thou wilt. and I will give [it] thee. 23 And he sware unto her, Whatsoever thou shalt ask

of me, I will give [it] thee, unto the half of my kingdom. ²⁴And she went forth, and said unto her mother, What shall I ask? And she said, The head of John the Baptist. ²⁵And she came in straightway with haste unto the king, and asked, saying, I will that thou give me by and by in a charger the head of John the Baptist. ²⁶And the king was exceeding sorry; [yet] for his oath's sake, and for their sakes which sat with him, he would not reject her. 27 And immediately the king sent an executioner, and commanded his head to be brought: and he went and beheaded him in the prison, 28 And brought his head in a charger, and gave it to the damsel: and the damsel gave it to her mother. 29 And when his disciples heard [of it], they came and took up his corpse, and laid it in a tomb.

John 1:19-21-- And this is the record of John, when the Jews sent priests and Levites from Jerusalem to ask him, Who art thou? 20 And he confessed, and denied not; but confessed, I am not the Christ. 21 And they asked him. What then? Art thou Elias? And he saith, I am not. Art thou that prophet? And he answered, No.

Matt. 17:10-13-- And his disciples asked him, saying, Why then say the scribes that Elias must first come? 11 And Jesus answered and said unto them, Elias truly shall first come, and restore all things. 12 But I say unto you, That Elias is come already, and they knew him not, but have done unto him whatsoever they listed. Likewise shall also the Son of man suffer of them. ¹³Then the disciples understood that he spake unto them of John

the Baptist.

GCS: 31.3-32.2 - John the Baptist's statement that he himself was not the Elijah, and Jesus' statement that John was the Elijah of that day, not of our day, clear three points: 4(1) That Iohn was not in any sense of the word fulfilling the mission of the Elijah who is to come be-

fore the great and dreadful day of the Lord. but that he, the last prophet to the church of his day, simply came in the spirit and power of Elijah, to prepare the way for the Lord's first advent. So it is that the Elijah of the great and dreadful day of the Lord, the last prophet to the church of this day, comes in the same spirit and power, to prepare the way for the Lord's second advent. 1(2) That as John was the Elijah of his day, yet not Elijah the Tishbite himself, then the promise of the prophet Elijah is not necessarily to be fulfilled in person by the ancient prophet himself. 2(3) That as the Elijah of Christ's first advent was one person, and also as the Elijah of Mt. Carmel of old was one person, not a multitude of priests, then by parity of reasoning the Elijah of today must also be one person, not a multitude of ministers.

Let us illustrate what we have just read--

Thus far, we see that John the Baptist prepared the way for Christ's first advent. He was the last prophet to the Jewish Church, and he preached until he was imprisoned and later beheaded. We also see that John the Baptist appeared almost two thousand years ago, and as he was preparing the way for Christ's first advent, Christ came to His temple, but not to purify the sons of Levi. Note that "the Elijah of the great and dreadful day of the Lord," is the last prophet to the Church of this day, he will prepare the way for Christ's second advent, and he appears just before "the great and dreadful day of the Lord."

Let us now read about the second mission in Elijah's typology, the mission immediately after John's. We will begin with the type, the establishment, of this part of the mission--

Lev. 16:29-34-- And [this] shall be a statute for ever unto you: [that] in the seventh month, on the tenth [day] of the month, ye shall afflict your souls, and do no work at all, [whether it be] one of your own country, or a stranger that sojourneth among you: 30 For on that day shall [the priest] make an atonement for you, to cleanse you, [that] ye may be clean from all your sins before the LORD. 31 It [shall be] a sabbath of rest unto you, and ye shall afflict your souls, by a statute for ever. 32 And the priest, whom he shall anoint, and whom he shall consecrate to minister in the priest's office in his father's stead, shall make the atonement, and shall put on the linen clothes, [even] the holy garments: ³³And he shall make an atonement for the holy sanctuary, and he shall make an atonement for the tabernacle of the congregation, and for the altar, and he shall make an atonement for the priests, and for all the people of the congregation. ³⁴And this shall be an everlasting statute unto you, to make an atonement for the children of Israel for all their sins once a year. And he did as the LORD commanded Moses.

These Scriptures reveal the typical day of atonement. Let us now hear of the antitype--

In like manner, the types which relate to the second advent must be fulfilled at the time pointed out in the symbolic service. Under the Mosaic system, the cleansing of the sanctuary, or the great day of atonement, occurred on the tenth day of the seventh Jewish month, [Leviticus 16:29-34.] when the high priest, having made an atonement for all Israel, and thus removed their sins from the sanctuary, came forth and blessed the people. So it was

believed that Christ, our great High Priest, would appear to purify the earth by the destruction of sin and sinners, and to bless his waiting people with immortality. The tenth day of the seventh month, the great day of atonement, the time of the cleansing of the sanctuary, which in the year 1844 fell upon the 22nd of October, was regarded as the time of the Lord's coming. This was in harmony with the proofs already presented that the 2300 days would terminate in the autumn, and the conclusion seemed irresistible. - GC 399.4

Once a year, on the great Day of Atonement, the priest entered the most holy place for the cleansing of the sanctuary. The work there performed completed the yearly round of ministration. On the Day of Atonement two kids of the goats were brought to the door of the tabernacle, and lots were cast upon them, "one lot for the Lord, and the other lot for the scapegoat." Verse 8. The goat upon which fell the lot for the Lord was to be slain as a sin offering for the people. And the priest was to bring his blood within the veil and sprinkle it upon the mercy seat and before the mercy seat. The blood was also to be upon the altar of incense that was before the veil. - GC 419.1

"And Aaron shall lay both his hands upon the head of the live goat, and confess over him all the iniquities of the children of Israel, and all their transgressions in all their sins, putting them upon the head of the goat, and shall send him away by the hand of a fit man into the wilderness: and the goat shall bear upon him all their iniquities unto a land not inhabited." Verses 21, 22. The scapegoat came no more into the camp of Israel, and the man who led him away was required to wash himself and his clothing with water before returning to the camp. - GC 419.2

The whole ceremony was designed to impress the Israelites with the holiness of God and His abhorrence of sin; and, further, to show them that they could not come in contact with sin without becoming polluted. Every man was required to afflict his soul while this work of atonement was going forward.

All business was to be laid aside, and the whole congregation of Israel were to spend the day in solemn humiliation before God, with prayer, fasting, and deep searching of heart. - GC 419.3

Important truths concerning the atonement are taught by the typical service. A substitute was accepted in the sinner's stead; but the sin was not canceled by the blood of the victim. A means was thus provided by which it was transferred to the sanctuary. By the offering of blood the sinner acknowledged the authority of the law, confessed his quilt in transgression, and expressed his desire for pardon through faith in a Redeemer to come; but he was not yet entirely released from the condemnation of the law. On the Day of Atonement the high priest, having taken an offering from the congregation, went into the most holy place with the blood of this offering, and sprinkled it upon the mercy seat, directly over the law, to make satisfaction for its claims. Then, in his character of mediator, he took the sins upon himself and bore them from the sanctuary. Placing his hands upon the head of the scapegoat, he confessed over him all these sins, thus in figure transferring them from himself to the goat. The goat then bore them away, and they were regarded as forever separated from the people. - GC 420.1

The subject of the sanctuary was the key which unlocked the mystery of the disappointment of 1844. It opened to view a complete system of truth, connected and harmonious, showing that God's hand had directed the great advent movement and revealing present duty as it brought to light the position and work of His people. As the disciples of Jesus after the terrible night of their anquish and disappointment were "glad when they saw the Lord," so did those now rejoice who had looked in faith for His second coming. They had expected Him to appear in glory to give reward to His servants. As their hopes were disappointed, they had lost sight of Jesus, and with Mary at the sepulcher they cried: "They have taken away my Lord, and I know not where they have laid Him." Now

in the holy of holies they again beheld Him, their compassionate High Priest, soon to appear as their king and deliverer. Light from the sanctuary illumined the past, the present, and the future. They knew that God had led them by His unerring providence. Though, like the first disciples, they themselves had failed to understand the message which they bore, yet it had been in every respect correct. In proclaiming it they had fulfilled the purpose of God, and their labor had not been in vain in the Lord. Begotten "again unto a lively hope," they rejoiced "with joy unspeakable and full of glory." - GC 423.1

Both the prophecy of Daniel 8:14, "Unto two thousand and three hundred days; then shall the sanctuary be cleansed," and the first angel's message, "Fear God, and give glo-

ry to Him; for the hour of His judgment is come," pointed to Christ's ministration in the most holy place, to the investigative judgment, and not to the coming of Christ for the redemption of His people and the de-

struction of the wicked. The mistake had not been in the reckoning of the prophetic periods, but in the event to take place at the end of the 2300 days. Through this error the believers had suffered disappointment, yet all that was foretold by the prophecy, and all that they had any Scripture warrant to expect, had been accomplished. At the very time when they were lamenting the failure of their hopes, the event had taken place which was foretold by the message, and which must be fulfilled before the Lord could appear to give reward to His servants. - GC 424.1

Christ had come, not to the earth, as they expected, but, as foreshadowed in the type, to the most holy place of the temple of God in heaven. He is represented by the prophet Daniel as coming at this time to the Ancient of Days: "I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven,

and came"--not to the earth, but--"to the Ancient of Days, and they brought Him near before Him." Daniel 7:13. - GC 424.2

Parents felt the deepest solicitude for their children. Those who received the message, labored with their unconverted friends and relatives, and with their souls bowed with the weight of the solemn message, warned and entreated them to prepare for the coming of the Son of man. Those cases were the most hardened that would not yield to such a weight of evidence set home by heart-felt warnings. This soul-purifying work led the affections away from worldly things, to a consecration never before experienced. Thousands were led to embrace the truth preached by Wm. Miller, and servants of God were raised up in the spirit and power of Elijah to proclaim the message. Those

who preached this solemn message, like John the forerunner of Jesus, felt compelled to lay the axe at the root of the tree, and call upon men to bring forth fruits meet for repentance. Their

testimony was calculat-

ed to arouse and powerfully affect the churches, and manifest their real character. And as they raised the solemn warning to flee from the wrath to come, many who were united with the churches received the healing message; they saw their backslidings, and, with bitter tears of repentance, and deep agony of soul, humbled themselves before God. And as the Spirit of God rested upon them, they helped to sound the cry, Fear God, and give glory to him, for the hour of his judgment is come. -1SG 133.2

On October 22, 1844, the first day of the antitypical day of atonement, the people of God were indeed prepared for Jesus to move to the Holiest apartment of the Heavenly sanctuary, even though they did not understand their mission as to the event to begin the day. Inspiration typified William Miller as being raised up in the spirit and power of Elijah. Let us add Brother William's part in the mission of Elijah's typology to the illustration--

At this juncture, we see that Brother William Miller began his call in 1831 and ended it in 1844 after the disappointment. He prepared the people for the antitypical day of atonement, which began on October 22, 1844. Let us now move to the third part to the mission of Elijah--

GCS: 37.2 - "We say, then, that we believe that the third angel's message is now completing the fulfillment of Malachi 4:5, 6. Hence, let none be bequiled with the fancy that Elijah is yet personally to appear, but give heed to the work already going on before their eyes." --"Review and Herald," February 23, 1864.

GCS: 41.3 - "Prophecy must be fulfilled. The Lord says: 'Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the Lord.' Somebody is to come in the spirit and power of Elijah, and when he appears, men may say: 'You are too earnest, you do not interpret the Scriptures in the proper way. Let me tell you how to teach your message." -- "Testimonies to Ministers," pp. 475, 476. (Quoted from "The Review and Herald," February 18, 1890.)

Note that in 1864, the Spirit of Prophecy revealed that the work that was going on then was "completing the fulfillment of Malachi 4:5,6." Then, in 1890, the Spirit of Prophecy further revealed that someone else was

to come in the spirit and power of Elijah, giving us the next phase of the typology. Then, in 1954, the SROD tells us that Sister White's work was only a preparatory part of Elijah's mission. Let us read it--

GCS: 39.1 - The Judgment for the Dead, furthermore, is not the message of "the great and dreadful day." It does not even touch on the prophecies of the great and dreadful day of the Lord. And since the one by whom the message on the Judgment for the Dead was unfolded has already been dead these many years, and since nothing, not to mention "all things," has as yet been restored, and, too, since that one never claimed to be the Elijah, nor to unfold the prophecies of the Judgment for the Living, no one, therefore, can honestly and innocently say Elijah has already come and gone. In view of these facts, it would be stupidity of the lowest form, if not blasphemy, for any one to lay such charges to her, or to imagine that her prophetic office fulfilled anything more than a preparatory part of the mission of Elijah.

Here we see that Sister Ellen G. White also had a part in the mission of Elijah. Let us illustrate this part of the typology--Sister E. G. White started her work 179 years ago, and her part of the mission was to be a founder of the SDA Church and give it the judgment of the dead Message. We now move to the next preparatory part of the mission of Elijah--

TN13: 44.1 - 1929 First Present Truth study given (Isa. 54) January 6.

TN13: 44.2 - 1930 The truth of the 144,000 revealed February 1.

SR1: 47.1 - It is at this time the 144,000 are marked, or sealed. Ezekiel 9 fits Elijah's experience for this reason: The prophet, or the message is called, Elijah, "with the spirit and the power of Elijah." The prophet Elijah thought all Israel had apostatized, and that he alone was left, but the Lord said He had 7,000 men that had not bowed a knee to Baal. "Seven" signifies a complete or perfect number, which stands as a symbol, in this instance meaning a complete number of thousands. The complete number of the very elect is 144,000. So we, too, like Elijah, think the whole church is drifted into the world (bowed a knee to Baal). Thus Elijah stands as a type of the 144,000 living, translated saints.

Let us first address the erroneous teaching that "antitypical Elijah is the 144,000," pursuant to this statement. This statement points out that Elijah thought he was the only one serving God then, but he was wrong. God had 7,000 men who had not bowed a knee to Baal. We, the future translated saints, likewise, will think as he did; thus, he typifies the 144,000. The Elijah on Mt. Carmel with King Ahab was one man, so it must be with the antitype.

Note carefully that the prophet or the Message is called Elijah, which means that when a statement mentions only the name, we must let the context identify if it is speaking of the prophet or the Message. But, under no circumstances can we, in our comprehension, replace or substitute one for the other when one is given in the sentence. If we do, we are violating the Lord's instructions and replacing them with human wisdom. In other words, Davidia's replacement theology, the teaching which instructs that because Brother Houteff is dead Elijah the prophet is replaced with Elijah the Message. Let us hear God's warning against this theology--

SR1: 143.2 - Suppose you would add an element to the milk, would it not be a strange one? And if it be a strange one to the milk, would it be foreign to the human system? If this be true, we must conclude it would be poison to the human body. "But," you say, "suppose I add the element of iron, it would not then be poison." By adding another element, it would put the milk out of balance, and it would be milk no longer. It is impossible for human wisdom to improve on God's work. Just so, it is impossible for us to neglect one of God's words and yet maintain spiritual life, neither can we add, though the thing may be good, as we may see it. It would throw the Word out of balance, and it would be God's Word no longer, just as the milk would be milk no longer. God's Word must be kept in the human heart, pure and unadulterated, if we must live by it. "This robe, woven in the loom of heaven has in it not one thread of human devising." -- Christ's Object Lessons, page 311.

SR2: 137.4 - While Sunday was growing more and more sacred, the Seventh-day Sabbath was on the decline, and becoming less and less holy. Here we see an example that should be marked carefully by all Christians. To add anything to the religion of Christ, though it may seem good on the surface, results in a deadly sting from beneath. Our God has devised a religion sufficient to save the church, if carefully followed. He needs no man's help, neither can He accept man-made devices.

SR2: 138.1 - "For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book: And if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book." (Rev. 22:18,19.)

SR2: 138.2 - The Roman church displaced the simplicity of the truth with human wisdom and traditions of man. Or, as Daniel puts it: "An host [Pagan flood] was given him against the daily by reason of transgression, and it cast down the truth to the ground; and it practiced, and prospered." (Dan. 8:12.) The "host" against the "daily" were the unconverted Pagans brought into the church; therefore, "by reason of transgression." How different from the method employed by John the Baptist! "But when he saw many of the Pharisees and Saducees come to his baptism, he said unto them, O generation of vipers, who hath warned you to flee from the wrath to come? Bring forth therefore fruits meet for repentance." (Matt. 3:7, 8.)

1SC4: 1.2 - Teach the message as it is -- add nothing to it, neither take anything from it. Do not feel that it is your duty to answer everybody's questions, or to explain the whole Bible and the Spirit of Prophecy. Only a silly person attempts such a thing. The scroll is not yet unrolled that far. Do not go beyond what the SRod has explained. Ask your opponents if they can give an answer to everything that has been written. Only simpletons feel capable of so doing. Their supposed correct answers in the past now, in the unrolling of the scroll, prove to be no answers at all. There was never a prophet who claimed to explain everything to his opponents even though the questions to be answered were concerning his own message. All those who demanded an explanation on every detail before taking their stand, fell into the "bottomless pit."

What have we learnt from these statements? Just this: when the statement says Elijah the Message, it must remain as is and be understood as it is written, likewise when the statement says Elijah the prophet. The same must apply when the statement says "they," referring to the prophet and the Message. Elijah's Message cannot be understood when you employ Davidia's replacement theology.

Let us continue with the fourth part, and to do so, we must first read the methodology of the Elijah typology that Christ our Lord put in place--

Matt. 17:11-13-- And Jesus answered and said unto them, Elias truly shall first come, and restore all things. But I say unto you, That Elias is come already, and they knew him not, but have done unto him whatsoever they listed. Likewise shall also the Son of man suffer of them. Then the disciples understood that he spake unto them of John the Baptist.

Note that our Lord Jesus first spoke of Elijah, who shall come and "restore all things". Then He starts His next sentence with the word "but," indicating that the words following the "but" could be deemed contradictory or, better yet, a paradox. Jesus' words following the "but" spoke of the present mission of Elijah being fulfilled by John the Baptist. He thus paved the way for multiple parts of Elijah's mission, as we have already seen thus far in this presentation. In our next statement to continue with the fourth part of the mission, the *Rod* employs the same mode of revelation as our Lord Jesus did Matthew 17:11-13--

Here is what Inspiration Itself has to say concerning the prophet's means of taking his message to the church:

GCS: 34.3 -"Behold upon the mountains the feet of him that bringeth good tidings, that published peace! O Judah, keep thy solemn feasts, perform thy vows: for the wicked shall no more pass through thee, he is utterly cut off." Nah. 1:15.

GCS: 35.1 - Thus you have it from the Lord, through His prophet Nahum, that the one who announces that the time has come for the wicked to be cut off from among God's people, and that the Judgment for the Living (which, as we have already seen, is "the great and

dreadful day of the Lord") is about to take place, is to make the announcement of these events by his publications. Further concerning this timely truth this "meat in due season," Isaiah declares that it will be dispensed to all without their having to pay for it -- "without money and without price." He urges them, moreover, to stop wasting their money in purchasing "that which is not bread" (Isa. 55:1, 2) -- that which is not inspired of God.

...when the

GCS: 35.2 - What is the Lord's counsel concerning the Voice of Elijah's publications? and what is the title of them?

> GCS: 35.3 - The answer comes through Micah the prophet:

GCS: 35.4 "The Lord's voice crieth unto the city, and the man of wisdom shall see thy name: hear ye the Rod, and Who hath appointed it." Mic. 6:9.

Message. GCS: 35.5 - Here is a Rod which speaks; and its voice, the scripture points out, is the voice of God to His And since "The Shepherd's people. Rod," the publications which contain the message of "the great and dreadful day of the Lord," is the only Rod that has ever spoken, then it is the "Rod" publications which the Lord demands all to hear. Some may call the publications "offshoot," others may call them "rubbish" ("Counsels on Sabbath School Work," p. 29), but the Lord titles them the "Rod," and His counsel is that we hear Its voice. In truth, since the Rod is a symbol of authority, correction, and deliverance, then what other title could more fittingly signify that It is to deliver the penitent and do away with the impenitent? It was the Shepherd's Rod that freed ancient Israel, and the Lord has chosen "The Shepherd's Rod" to deliver modern Israel. It was a Rod that led the first Exodus, and it is now seen that a Rod is making ready to lead the second Exodus (Isa. 11:11; Mic. 7:14, 15; Ezek. 20:36, 37).

Note that in **paragraph two** on **page 34**, that the *Rod* first spoke of Elijah, who is to warn the Laodiceans of "*the great* and the dreadful day of the Lord." He is to be one person and is to have faithful helpers. Then, the word "but" is used to switch to the present Elijah, as our Lord Jesus did in Matthew 17:12. The present Elijah when the statement was written, is none other than the author of Elijah's Message, Brother V. T. Houteff, who is now dead and cannot fulfill the mission of Elijah of "the great and dreadful day of the Lord," the one mentioned before the word "but" in the sentence. These references will suffice, let us follow the illustration--

Thus far, we see that Brother V. T. Houteff started his mission 95 years ago, which ended in 1955 at his death. He gave us the judgment of the living Message, also called the Elijah Message, and founded the Davidian Seventh-day Adventist Church. We have presented enough evidence to show the last prophet in the Church will be the antitypical Elijah, Elijah of "the great and dreadful day of the Lord." The type demands translation. Therefore, the last prophet to the Church, the Church which will be translated, must also be a translated saint. To help those who believe and teach that Bro. V. T. Houteff is the last prophet to the Church and will be resurrected to fulfill the final part of the mission of Elijah's typology; we present the following evidence to correct their doctrine-

THE LAST PROPHET MUST RESTORE **ALL THINGS**

3SC2: 6.1.4 - And Jesus says: "Elias verily cometh first, and restoreth all things." (Mk. Therefore, Elijah's coming must precede both the great and dreadful day of the Lord and His second coming; and when he comes, he must restore all things.

3SC2: 6.2.5 - Moreover, how could the Word say that Elijah must restore all things if he were not also going to restore the marriage institution? Furthermore, if God saw that it was not good for man to be alone originally in the Garden of Eden, then why should it be good for him when he returns to Eden? Or shall we all now, in this time of gathering, and of receiving the inheritance of the first dominion, divorce our wives?

GCS: 39.1 - ...since nothing, not to mention "all things," has as yet been restored, ...

Note carefully that in 1954, in the revised 1950 General Conference Special, the *Rod* says nothing has been restored. We have already shown that Brother Houteff is resurrecting in the time of "the great and the dreadful day of the Lord," whereas the restoring of all things begins at the beginning of "the great and the dreadful day of the Lord" for the Church. We have also read that the last prophet comes before "the great and the dreadful day of the Lord." Let's hear the Rod—

2TG31: 4.2 - At this coming He is not to take His saints to the mansions above, but He is to purify the sons of Levi -- the ministry; He is to destroy the leaders of idolatry. Since the purity of His servants is first to be restored, the restoration, therefore, commences in the Church. Thus is the Edenic state of peace and security to be restored, ...

TN8: 60.1 - Proclaiming "the great and dreadful day of the Lord" (Mal. 4:5), "a day of slaughter" (Isa. 30:25), and "a day of darkness" (Joel 2:2), this last message is to be sounded at the eleventh hour -- just before the time in which, as John foresaw, "the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains; and said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of Him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb: for the great day of His wrath is come; and who shall be able to stand" (Rev. 6:15-17)? -- none but the righteous, the future leaders of the church, as David's reign typifies.

1TG32: 21.1- Obviously, when God's waters of salvation cover the earth -- even to the tops of the mountains, so to speak -- then the watch towers (the pulpits), which the people have on their own initiative built, will fall. Doubtless the day of slaughter is the great and dreadful day of the Lord. So again we are brought face to face with the reality that Truth does one of two things -- if It cannot save, It destroys.

Doubtless, the slaughter marks the beginning of "the great and the dreadful day of the Lord" in the Church. In addition, the *Rod* says--

2TG30: 12.1 - This messenger of the covenant (of the promise), antitypical Elijah the prophet shall prepare the way; he shall restore all things. As he prepares the way, the Lord will suddenly come to His temple, to His church. And what is His work to be? To purify or cleanse His people by weeding the unrepented sinners from among them. The question:

"But who may abide the day of His coming?" solemnly declares that we had better now get busy and do what it takes to make us stand before the cleansing begins.

Note carefully, as Elijah "prepares the way, the Lord will suddenly come to His temple, to His Church." It is clear as crystal that the Lord did not suddenly come to His temple to purify it during Brother Houteff's mission. Let us continue with the help--

2TG30: 12.2 - Whom in particular will He purify? -- Let us read--

Mal. 3:3-- And He shall sit as a refiner and purifier of silver: and He shall purify the sons of Levi, and purge them as gold and silver, that they may offer unto the Lord an offering in righteousness.

2TG30: 12.3 - The Levites, you know, comprised the tribe from which came the priesthood, the ministers of the Lord. And since this prophecy is to meet its complete fulfillment in our day, the figure is clear: The Levites, the ministers of the Lord in our day, are to be purified. What then?

Mal. 3:4-- Then shall the offering of Judah and Jerusalem be pleasant unto the Lord, as in the days of old, and as in former years.

Who are the ministers of today who need to be purified? The General Conference ministers or the Davidian servants, those who are entrusted with the Present Truth, the judgment of the living Message, and are now giving the trumpet over twenty-five uncertain sounds, no two the same? Here is the answer--

2TG43: 12.1 - I say that if left in such an unhappy and unholy state the very elect would forever remain unclean and unsanctified -- deceived! And since the eleventh-hour servants, the Davidians, are the ones unto whom the message of this cleansing, "the Judgment of the Living," is committed, then those who on account of it are our enemies, those who are doing everything they can to keep the common people ignorant of the Truth and from coming in contact with It, are the very ones who are endeavoring to deceive "the very elect," if possible. Thank God that it is impossible.

TN8: 49.2 - This revelatory statement conclusively proves that after the historical Minneapolis meeting in 1888, when the leaders rejected both the message and the counsel which was given them (Testimonies To Ministers, p. 468) the Lord did not any longer regard the General Conference as His servants, just as He did not any longer regard Saul as king over Israel after he turned from the Lord's commands to him. And now, having long since granted the popular demand to organize the General Conference, in fulfillment of the type, God warns that His forbearance is come to an end today just as it did then. ...

If this collection of references did not help the teacher with the false doctrine that Brother Houteff is the last prophet to the Church, nothing would. Let us leave them alone.

Without a doubt, we know that Elijah of "the great and the dreadful day of the Lord" will be the one to call the solemn assembly. As we said earlier, for there to be a showdown, there must be an assembly, and the Rod adds-- "from which not one is to be excluded." There are to be two trumpets sounding at different times: the first to announce the day, and the second to call the solemn assembly. Let us listen to this sound--

BLOW THE TRUMPET AND CALL THE SOLEMN ASSEMBLY

Joel 2:1-- Blow ye the trumpet in Zion, and sound an alarm in my holy mountain: let all the inhabitants of the land tremble: for the day of the LORD cometh, for [it is] nigh at hand;

Joel 2:15, 16-- Blow the trumpet in Zion, sanctify a fast, call a solemn assembly: 16 gather the people, sanctify the congregation, assemble the elders, gather the children, and those that suck the breasts: let the bridegroom go forth of his chamber, and the bride out of her closet.

2TG8: 21.3 - In these verses, as in Joel 2:1, the command is given to blow the trumpet in Zion. This second trumpet, however, is not to announce the day of God, but to sanctify both a fast and the people, to call a solemn assembly,

<u>from which not one is to be excluded from the</u> assembly.

Note that a fast, not a feast, precedes this solemn assembly. Therefore, this solemn assembly cannot be the Passover nor the Feast of Tabernacles, as some teach pursuant to the following Scriptures--

Deu. 16:8-- Six days thou shalt eat unleavened bread: and on the seventh day [shall be] a solemn assembly to the LORD thy God: thou shalt do no work [therein].

Lev. 23:36-- Seven days ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD: on the eighth day shall be an holy convocation unto you; and ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD: it [is] a solemn assembly; [and] ye shall do no servile work [therein].

These two solemn assemblies are not associated with a fast but rather a feast; this should help those who promulgate the solemn assembly of Joel 2:15 to be the Passover or the Feast of Tabernacles. Let us continue with the solemn assembly--

2SC9: 2.1.1 - "Blow the trumpet in Zion, sanctify a fast, call a solemn assembly: gather the people, sanctify the congregation, assemble the elders, gather the children, and those that suck the breast: let the bridegroom go forth of His chamber, and the bride out of her closet. Let the priests, the ministers of the Lord, weep between the porch and the altar, and let them say, Spare Thy people, O Lord, and give not thine heritage to reproach, that the heathen should rule over them: wherefore should they say among the people, Where is their God?" (Joel 2:15-17.)

2SC9: 2.1.2 - Joel's prophecy above quoted must meet its fulfillment in the time when probation's hours are fast closing, for the Word says, "Let the bridegroom go forth of His chamber, and the bride out of her closet." The term, "let", means to allow it to be so: and as the bridegroom is Christ at the time when He is to be crowned or married to the New Jerusalem -- His bride -- (Rev. 21:9), this scripture can not meet its fulfillment at any time other than when this event, to which all heaven and earth have been looking forward,

is about to take place. Therefore, the Lord is urging us to "blow the trumpet in Zion" (the church), and to hasten the time of crowning Him King of kings and Lord of lords -- the time in which He closes His mediatorial work, -- "goes forth of His chamber" -- the Most Holy place.

2SC9: 2.1.3 - The command, "Gather the people, sanctify the congregation, assemble the elders, gather the children, and those that suck the breasts," signifies a complete separation from the world of "old and young, both maids and little children, and women" "that sigh and that cry for all the abominations that be done in the midst thereof" (Ezek. 9:4,6): and being prophetically made to the church (Zion), this command evidences the fact that when the trumpet shall blow in fulfillment of this scripture, it will find Zion, His church, unsanctified and commingled with the world. Therefore, comes the call for sanctification.

2SC9: 2.1.4 - The conditions further prove that this scripture meets its fulfillment now, because the church at the present time has, by her institutions, entangled herself with the institutions of the world, but we thank the Lord that years ago the "Spirit of Prophecy" predicted that "somebody was to come in the spirit and power of Elijah" ("Testimonies to Ministers," p. 475), and that "God will have men who are true to duty. At the right time He sends His faithful messengers to do a work similar to that of Elijah." ("Testimonies for the Church," Vol. 5, p. 254.)

Here, we see that the **Rod** connects Joel's call for an assembly with the purification of the Church and, therefore, also with antitypical Elijah. The Scripture met only a partial fulfillment in the mission of Brother V. T. Houteff and will meet its complete fulfillment when the Bridegroom goes forth of His chambers, which suggests the Bridegroom coming for the judgment of the living. Let us continue--

3SC5,6: 12.2.2 - Daniel's prophecies are to be revealed "in the time of the end" (Dan. 12:4). Yet it would be unreasonable for one to conclude that these prophecies are to be revealed after the end of the world. Rather, they are to be revealed "at the end of the world," when "His angels shall come forth, and sever the wicked from among the just." (Matt. 13:49.) God has not commissioned the church to preach the gospel of an impure church, but to "Blow the trumpet in Zion, sanctify a fast, call a solemn assembly: gather the people, sanctify the congregation, assemble the elders, gather the children, and those that suck the breasts: let the bridegroom go forth of his chamber, and the bride out of her closet." (Joel 2:15-17.) For, "All the sinners of My people shall die by the sword, which say, The evil shall not overtake nor prevent us." (Amos 9:10.) "And it shall come to pass, that he that is left in Zion, and he that remaineth in 'Jerusalem, shall be called holy, even every one that is written among the living in Jerusalem." (Isa. 4:3.)

From these statements, we can easily see that the solemn assembly is connected to the purification of the Church. Let's hear some more--

Joel 2:1-3-- "Blow ye the trumpet in Zion, and sound an alarm in My holy mountain: let all the inhabitants of the land tremble: for the day of the Lord cometh, for it is nigh at hand; a day of darkness and of gloominess, a day of clouds and of thick darkness, as the morning spread upon the mountains: a great people and a strong; there hath not been ever the like, neither shall be any more after it, even to the years of many generations. A fire devoureth before them; and behind them a flame burneth: the land is as the garden of Eden before them, and behind them a desolate wilderness; yea, and nothing shall escape them."

2TG8: 19.2 - Here you see that a message is to be proclaimed to the church, to Zion, declaring that the great and dreadful day of the Lord is at hand; that it is to be devastating behind His people, and glorious ahead of them, -- that the Lord is thoroughly to comb the field, that He is to gather every grain of "wheat," and then burn the tares.

WHO SHALL ANTITYPICAL ELIJAH **CALL TO THE ASSEMBLY?**

ABN3: 64.3 - When it has accomplished this "closing work for the church" (Testimonies. Vol. 3, p. 266), then those who have overcome every "temptation in the strength of the Might One," who have sighed and cried and escaped the destruction will "be as David; and the house of David shall be as God, as the angel of the Lord before them." Zech. 12:8. Davidians indeed!--"a great people and a strong" (Joel 2:2), "clad in the armor of Christ's righteousness,...'fair as the moon, clear as the sun, and terrible as an army with banners, '... to go forth into all the world, conquering and to conquer." --Prophets and Kings, p. 725.

1TG7: 13.4 - Should we not be glad that while we are being invited to the Kingdom, we are also being told how to get there? Seeing all these, we must never let our confidence in God wane. We ought to be stable, firm in everything, lacking God's eleventh-hour servants, says nothing. Inspiration, are to be "a great people and a strong; there hath not been ever the like, neither shall be any more after it." Joel 2:2. They know what they believe, and believe what they know. Most important of all, they know that they are led by God, not by man.

The Davidians, the "eleventh-hour servants", are the ones called to this solemn assembly. What are they assembled for? To answer this question, we must begin with the type--

THE REASON FOR THE SOLEMN **ASSEMBLY**

1 Kings 18:19-21- Now therefore send, [and] gather to me all Israel unto mount Carmel, and the prophets of Baal four hundred and fifty, and the prophets of the groves four hundred, which eat at Jezebel's table. 20 So Ahab sent unto all the children of Israel, and gathered the prophets together unto mount Carmel. 21 And Elijah came unto all the people, and said, How long halt ye between two opinions? if the LORD [be] God, follow him: but if Baal, [then] follow him. And the people answered him not a word.

... Not one in that vast assembly dare reveal loyalty to J_H_V_H [blessed be the name of the Lord]. Like a dark cloud, deception and blindness had overspread Israel. Not all at once had this fatal apostasy closed about them, but gradually, as from time to time they had failed to heed the words of warning and reproof that the Lord sent them. Each departure from rightdoing, each refusal to repent, had deepened their guilt and driven them farther from Heaven. And now, in this crisis, they persisted in refusing to take their stand for God. - PK 147.3

The Lord abhors indifference and disloyalty in a time of crisis in His work. The whole universe is watching with inexpressible interest the closing scenes of the great controversy between good and evil. The people of God are nearing the borders of the eternal world; what can be of more importance to them than that they be loyal to the God of heaven? All through the ages, God has had moral heroes, and He has them now--those who, like Joseph and Elijah and Daniel, are not ashamed to acknowledge themselves His peculiar people. His special blessing accompanies the labors of men of action, men who will not be swerved from the straight line of duty, but who with divine energy will inquire, "Who is on the Lord's side?" (Exodus 32:26), men who will not stop merely with the inquiry, but who will demand that those who choose to identify themselves with the people of God shall step forward and reveal unmistakably their allegiance to the King of kings and Lord of lords. Such men make their wills and plans subordinate to the law of God. For love of Him they count not their lives dear unto themselves. Their work is to catch the light from the Word and let it shine forth to the world in clear, steady rays. Fidelity to God is their motto. - PK 148.1

1 Kings 18:22-26-- Then said Elijah unto the people, I, [even] I only, remain a prophet of the LORD; but Baal's prophets [are] four hundred and fifty men. 23Let them therefore give us two bullocks; and let them choose one bullock for themselves, and cut it in pieces, and lay [it] on wood, and put no fire [under]: and I will dress the other bullock, and lay [it] on wood, and put no fire [under]: 24 And call ye on

the name of your gods, and I will call on the name of the LORD: and the God that answereth by fire, let him be God. And all the people answered and said, It is well spoken. 25 And Elijah said unto the prophets of Baal, Choose you one bullock for yourselves, and dress [it] first; for ye [are] many; and call on the name of your gods, but put no fire [under]. 26And they took the bullock which was given them, and they dressed [it], and called on the name of Baal from morning even until noon, saying, O Baal, hear us. But [there was] no voice, nor any that answered. And they leaped upon the altar which was made.

Outwardly bold and defiant, but with terror in their quilty hearts, the false priests prepare their altar, laying on the wood and the victim; and then they begin their incantations. Their shrill cries echo and re-echo through the forests and the surrounding heights, as they

call on the name of their god, saying, "O Baal, hear us." The priests gather about their altar, and with leaping and writhing and screaming, with tearing of hair and cutting of flesh, they beseech their god to help them. - PK 149.2

The morning passes, noon comes, and yet there is no evidence that Baal hears the cries of his deluded followers. There is no voice, no reply to their frantic prayers. The sacrifice remains unconsumed. - PK 149.3

As they continue their frenzied devotions, the crafty priests are continually trying to devise some means by which they may kindle a fire upon the altar and lead the people to believe that the fire has come direct from Baal. But Elijah watches every movement; and the priests, hoping against hope for some opportunity to deceive, continue to carry on their senseless ceremonies. - PK 149.4

1 Kings 18:27-29-- And it came to pass at noon, that Elijah mocked them, and said, Cry aloud: for he [is] a god; either he is talking, or he is pursuing, or he is in a journey, [or] peradventure he sleepeth, and must be awaked. 28 And they cried aloud, and cut themselves after their manner with knives and lancets, till the blood gushed out upon them. ²⁹And it came to pass, when midday was past, and they prophesied until the [time] of the offering of the [evening] sacrifice, that [there was] neither voice, nor any to answer, nor any that regarded.

Gladly would Satan have come to the help of

those whom he had deceived, and who were devoted to his service. Gladly would he have sent the lightning to kindle their sacrifice. But I H V H [blessed be the name of the Lord] has set Satan's bounds, restrained his power, and not

all the enemy's devices can convey one spark to Baal's altar. - PK 150.1

At last, their voices hoarse with shouting, their garments stained with blood from self-inflicted wounds, the priests become desperate. With unabated frenzy they now mingle with their pleading terrible cursings of their sun-god, and Elijah continues to watch intently; for he knows that if by any device the priests should succeed in kindling their altar fire, he would instantly be torn in pieces. - PK 150.2

Evening draws on. The prophets of Baal are weary, faint, confused. One suggests one thing, and another something else, until finally they cease their efforts. Their shrieks and curses no longer resound over Carmel. In despair they retire from the contest. - PK 150.3

All day long the people have witnessed the demonstrations of the baffled priests. They have beheld their wild leaping round the

altar, as if they would grasp the burning rays of the sun to serve their purpose. They have looked with horror on the frightful, selfinflicted mutilations of the priests, and have had opportunity to reflect on the follies of idol worship. Many in the throng are weary of the exhibitions of demonism, and they now await with deepest interest the movements of Elijah. - PK 150.4

1 Kings 18:30-39-- And Elijah said unto all the people, Come near unto me. And all the people came near unto him. that thou [art] the LORD God, and [that] thou hast turned their heart back again. 38Then the fire of the LORD fell, and consumed the burnt sacrifice, and the wood, and the stones, and the dust, and licked up the water that [was] in the trench. ³⁹And when all the people saw [it], they fell on their faces: and they said, The LORD, he [is] the God; the LORD, he [is] the God.

In the reconstruction of this ancient altar, Elijah revealed his respect for the covenant that the Lord made with Israel when they crossed the Jordan into the Promised Land. Choosing "twelve stones, according to the number of the tribes of the sons of Jacob, . . . he built an altar in the name of the Lord." - PK 151.2

> The disappointed priests of Baal, exhausted by their vain efforts, wait to see what Elijah will do. They hate the prophet for proposing a test that has exposed the weakness and inefficiency of their gods; yet they fear his power. The people, fearful also, and almost breathless with expectancy, watch while Elijah continues his preparations. The calm demeanor of the prophet stands out in sharp contrast with the fanatical, senseless frenzy of the followers of Baal. - PK 151.3

The people on the mount prostrate themselves in awe before the unseen God. They dare not continue to look upon the Heaven-sent fire. They fear that they themselves will be consumed; and, convicted of their duty to acknowledge the God of Elijah as the God of their fathers, to whom they owe allegiance,

they cry out together as with one voice, "The Lord, He is the God; the Lord, He is the God." With startling distinctness the cry resounds over the mountain and echoes in the plain below. At last Israel is aroused, undeceived, penitent. At last the people see how greatly they have dishonored God. The character of Baal worship, in contrast with the reasonable service required by the true God, stands fully revealed. The people recognize God's justice and mercy in withholding the dew and the rain until they have been brought to confess His name. They are ready now to admit that the God of Elijah is above every idol. - PK 153.1

The priests of Baal witness with consternation the wonderful revelation of $J_H_V_H$'s [blessed be the name of the Lord] power. Yet even in their discomfiture and in the presence of divine glory, they refuse to repent of their evil-doing. They would still remain the prophets of Baal. Thus they showed themselves ripe for destruction. That repentant Israel may be protected from the allurements of those who have taught them to worship Baal, Elijah is directed by the Lord to destroy these false teachers. The anger of the people has already been aroused against the leaders in transgression; and when Elijah gives the command, "Take the prophets of Baal; let not one of them escape," they are ready to obey. They seize the priests, and take them to the brook Kishon, and there, before the close of the day that marked the beginning of decided reform, the ministers of Baal are slain. Not one is permitted to live. -

PK 153.2

Here, we see a **showdown** between Elijah, the prophet of God, and the prophets of Baal, Truth versus error. Elijah eventually mocked the prophets of Baal for their inability to prove Baal was a god. This gives us a perfect picture of what could be expected in the other **showdown**. The *ROD* of God in the hands of the Elijah of "the great and dreadful day of the Lord" versus the rods of Davidia. This is the other **showdown** from which none would be absent. Let us hear some more of what is to be expected--

1SC14: 6.2 [8/15/1935] - As Amos says, "The

habitations of the shepherds shall mourn," it is obvious that Amos' prophecy is yet future, for the word "habitations" (places) is in the plural form which; cannot be applied to one shepherd's habitation (denomination) but to all that be in existence at that time. The term "shepherds" means, as understood, the same as "the ancient men which were before the house" -- the ministers. -- "Testimonies for the Church," Vol. 5, p. 211. Note that the shepherds are not themselves to mourn but their "habitations (their houses); that is, the membership of their churches, which fact reveals that it will be thus at the time when the sleeping multitudes in the churches awake from their spiritual insensibility and find that the shepherds whom they have implicitly trusted for their salvation had deceived all those who followed them.

In this 1935 statement, in interpreting the plurality of the word "habitations", the Rod applied it to other denominations since it was understood at that time that Mt. Carmel might be the place for gathering the great multitude (See 1SC16: 15.1 and 3SC11-12: 2.1.6). Later, in 1937, when the light of the Kingdom was revealed, it was understood from then on that the Kingdom, in Palestine, is where the great multitude would be gathered into. Then, at the end of 1948, in 2TG41, the ROD applied Amos' prophecy to a **showdown** on antitypical Mt. Carmel, which would have nothing to do with the great multitude, for the **showdown** is before the purification of the Church, as previously pointed out. When we unite these paragraphs in the order of their progressive revelation, we can better understand the correct application of the paragraphs on page 6 of 1SC14 in light of the up-to-date truth. A plurality of habitation emerged in the Davidian movement, beginning in 1955; now, in 2024, there are over twenty-five groups in Davidia, and that number is still increasing. At the showdown prophesied, the habitations, the membership of Davidia, are the ones to mourn when the Lord's **ROD** swallows up the rods of their teachers who are twisting the Truth. The members will see clearly that they have been fed with dung that came forth from men. They will finally learn that the war and the confederacy they are looking for are a mirage. They will cry out that the New Codes are not the *Rod*, and that there is a prophet in the Church, who had turned the hearts of the parents to their children and the hearts of the children to their

parents. Sadly, it will be too late. Before the **showdown**, as Davidia awaits to go and "say, ye, not a confederacy", a call is made by antitypical Elijah for all to go out and meet the Bridegroom, but 24,000 foolish Davidians will not see the Bridegroom. Instead, they will see the sudden war over Jerusalem after months of what appeared to be peace.

What is the sign for the meek of the earth just before the Lord returns for the judgment of the living?--

2TG41: 13.1 - These verses of Scripture, you note, are to meet fulfillment just before the "day pass as the chaff," before the fierce anger of the Lord breaks upon the nation not desired. And while this undesired nation is gathering together, then it is that all the meek of the earth, those who have borne the Lord's message "before the great and dreadful day of the Lord" (the church), are counselled to still seek

meekness. There are, therefore, two peoples brought to view in these verses -- the nation not desired and the meek of the earth.

1TG22: 24.3 - When this **Judgment-bound** nation begins to gather together then it is, if never before, that the meek of the earth need to seek meekness.

...all the meek of the earth, those who have borne the Lord's message "before the great and dreadful day of the Lord" (the church), are counselled to still seek meekness

Let us note that the gathering of the Jews since 1948 and before will be as nothing when compared to the gathering just ahead. The hatred of the identifiable Jews of today will intensify around the world, and their only hope of life preservation, as they see it, is the land of Israel. Thus, in advance, the acquisitions of Gaza, Golan Heights, and the West Bank are absolutely necessary to make room for the expected migration. Now!!! Let the meek of the earth seek meekness so they can still seek it when the migration explodes.

1SC14: 6.3 [8/15/1935] - The prophet Jeremiah in the following words explains that this wailing by those who are thus deceived will be at the close of probation. For they shall say "the harvest is past, the summer is ended, and we are not saved." (Jer. 8:20.) That is, af-

ter the harvest, the time in which they could have been saved, they will realize that probationary time has closed. Then "the habitations of the shepherds shall mourn, and the top of Carmel shall wither." Hence, before that time the top of Carmel must have been green with much pasture, otherwise there would be nothing to wither; that is, though Carmel has now plenty of pasture (present truth), when probation closes it shall be deserted ("wither"), for says the Spirit of Prophecy: "In the time of trouble we all fled from the cities and villages." -- "Early Writings," p. 34.

How sad it will be that day as the laity of Davidia mourns the shame of their false teachers. The arrival of the Eleventh-hour Church, formerly Wave-sheaf Ministries, on the top of antitypical Mt. Carmel in 2009 caused it to be "green with much pasture," but

> Davidia refuses to hear the pure ROD. Some see the truth but are afraid to leave their beloved friends, while others refuse to investigate because the leaders said not to. Let us hear two other statements pertaining to Jer. 8:20--

> > TN3: 70.3 [1942] -The second section of the separation thus being completed. **Probationary**

time is closed. Whereupon from the wicked will be heard the horrible wail of doom: "The harvest is past, the summer is ended, and we are not saved." Jer. 8:20.

TN3: 71.1 - This being the dreadful experience of the tares in Babylon, in the second section of the harvest, there must, as a type, be a similar and precedent experience for the tares in the Laodicean church, in the first section of the harvest, a parallel which shows conclusively that The Church Is Not Babylon.

These two statements show that there is a double application to the interpretation of Jer. 8:20, so it is with the other contiguous statements. Let us read the other--

1SC14: 6.4 [8/15/1935] - Thus shall the top

of Carmel wither, and those who do not take heed to the word, "To day if ye will hear His voice, harden not your heart," at length will be alarmed that their opportunity for accepting the truth has slipped away. Then in their hasty, frenzied effort to acquaint themselves with present truth which went forth from the top of Carmel, to their surprise they shall find that Carmel has finished its work, its inhabitants removed, and probation closed, at which time the inhabitants of "Carmel" can but repeat, "the harvest is past, the summer is ended, and we have nothing for thee."

Note carefully that it is the "habitations of Carmel," referring to Davidians, for the Davidians are the inhabitants of Mt. Carmel, not the Laodiceans, and habitation is in its plural. Here we see that the all-knowing God of the Rod addressed the plurality of the "habitations of Carmel." For more understanding of the statement just read, we must couple it with this one--

SR2: 185.3 - The knowledge of present truth, which the five foolish virgins possessed since 1844 is the judgment of the dead, and was the only oil in their lamps. When the judgment of the living commenced, and the "cry was made," they were found without this extra oil in their vessels; they had neglected their Lord's command: "Watch therefore, for ye know neither the day nor the hour wherein the Son of man cometh." Thus when the wise ones started out to meet the bridegroom the lamps of the foolish went out, for, the judgment of the dead had passed. Therefore, it was present truth no more, and thus they were left in darkness. At the beginning of the judgments of God they saw their mistake and rushed for the ark of safety, but it was beyond their reach for they knew nothing of the message, and by the time they acquired it (filled their lamps with oil), there had been a delay, the angel had passed "through the city, through Jerusalem," the church -- the sealing was finished, and probation for the church had closed -- the door was shut. Thus they were left out. Then they came with these words: "Lord, Lord, open unto us, But He answered and said, Verily I say unto you,

I know you not." "Appoint his portion with the hypocrites: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth." What a disappointment that will be!

Here, we see the foolish virgins acquired the extra oil even though the wise virgins refused to give it to them, the same as the statement in 1SC14: 6.4, which said Carmel had finished its work and had nothing for them. It shows that the Truth must be available online for the foolish virgins to consume.

Then finally, we must couple them all with this statement--

LDSDA: 3.2 - ... Second, it purports itself to be the first of the first fruits of the living, the vanguard from among the present-day descendants of those Jews who composed the Early Christian Church. With the emergence of this vanguard and its army, the first fruits, from which are elected the 12,000 out of each of the twelve tribes of Jacob, "the 144,000" (Rev. 14:1; 7:2-8) who stand on Mount Zion with the Lamb (Rev. 14:1; 7:2-8), the reign of antitypical David begins.

Here, we see the first fruits harvest is in two sections, which helps to understand that these statements are more applicable to the first of the first fruits section of the first harvest. We will spend more time on this in our next issue of the Symbolic Code.

IN SUMMARY

- The solemn assembly will be for the antitypical showdown on Mt. Carmel, Waco, Texas.
- The solemn assembly will be called by "the Elijah of the great and dreadful day of the Lord."
- Brother V. T. Houteff was not the last prophet to the church; neither was he "the Elijah of the great and dreadful day of the Lord."
- The antitypical **showdown** will be between "the Elijah of the great and dreadful day of the Lord" and the false prophets of Davidia.
- The antitypical **showdown** will, in essence, be the **Rod** of God versus the rods of Davidia, Truth versus error.



VTC CAMP


Planting activities have beautified the surroundings, and the premises are much cleaner.

Two tanks, each with a 10,000 litre capacity, were purchased to help harvest water from the heavy rains.





extended to Lusaka, Kitwe, Ibenga and Mumbwa. The members were blessed with a wealth of knowledge.









DYAYA QUIZ


The Quiz sessions are the most recent activities which started in July 2024 on every 3rd Sabbath.





STRUCTURAL COMPOSITION OF FAMILY LIFE DEPARTMENT

The Family Life Department was formed in October 2023 with the appointment of two leaders. Now the department has got other departments currently under its umbrella. Previously, the DAVIDIAN KINGS, PRINCE AND PRIESTS SOCIETY (DKPPS) and QUEEN ESTHER SISTER'S SOCIETY (QESS) were functioning independently but they are now under the FLD.

FLD COMMITTEE

We have a family life committee, comprising of representatives from the married (couples,) singles, and leaders from the DKPPS, QESS, and the Children's Departments.

- Both the DKPPS and QESS are allowed to plan and execute their plans independently
- DKPPS deals with the men (Brothers) in the Church
- QESS deals with the women (Sisters) in the Church
- Their leaders are part of the FLD Committee.
- The Children Department has been in the making since January 2024 and there has been significant progress

ACCOMPLISHMENTS IN THE JUST ENDED YEAR

The FLD was put in place at the beginning of the fiscal year. Though much of the accomplishment in the just ended fiscal year was targeted towards organization, we are still grateful to God for what He allowed us to accomplish.

FORMATION OF THE FLD COMMITTEE

The Family Life Department Committee was established with representatives from Kenya, Uganda and Zambia Divisions and from QESS and DKPPS.

Key Roles of the Committee

- To keep track and have accurate record of the families in the Church.
- Ensure representation at Division level and have a link to the areas of each division to help solve family problems.
- Provide a means for collaboration between DKPPS (the men in the church) and QESS (the women in the church).
- Deal with all other matters relating to the families in the church. Answer questions concerning families, give counselling where applicable and arrange ministerial counselling.

Some Achievements of the FLD Committee

- Advancement in the arrangement of the family life seminars in the various divisions.
- Currently working on the comprehensive guide to the preparation of the Davidian marriage.
- Working with the FSO to organize presenters for the first Sabbath of every month.
- Cooperation with other departments (QESS, DKPPS and Children) to brainstorm how to increase members involvement.

IMPLEMENTATION OF THE FIRST **SABBATH OF THE MONTH WORSHIP**

With the help of the FSO, we have allocated the first Sabbath of every month to family life and health. In the family life segment, we deal with issues that affect us at the family level.

The QESS department became inactive due to the fact that active members were being appointed to perform other important roles in the Church. Due to this, the Society stopped having the fortnight meetings and other activities, even at Division level, lessened. It was expedient that the Society activities be revamped. The following was done to improve the situation.

- Appointed the Co-Secretary of the FLD Sis. Esther Mwaba to be the coordinator for **QESS**
- Resumed the fortnight meetings every Thursday of the first and third week of the month, even though attendance needs to improve
- We have tried to encourage QESS activities at the Division level and in some way it is yielding though there is need for member involvement
- We have facilitated some counselling sessions for sisters with the minister





- The minister was able to travel to Florida two times to meet and share with brethren from Waco 2500. The second meeting, Brother Lennox met and shared with two of the main teachers of Waco 2500.

- With all these efforts we have a number of prospects from the USA, Botswana, South Africa, Zimbabwe and DR Congo who are investigating the Truth.
- On February 3rd the MD opened up an office in Zambia, Monze area. There are fourteen converts and eight are still investigating. Brothers Vincent Hanzooma and Maimbo Mweemba are the two teachers in the Monza MD office and are currently working to become Heaven's Appeal Teachers.

- May He oversee the swift completion of the project.


PROOFREADING AND SECOND **PRINTING**

errors, etc. that made their way into the first printing be identified and corrected,


proofreading was necessary.







WESTERN HEMISPHERE REPORT



SABBATH-DAY GATHERINGS


Every fifth Sabbath we have the opportunity to come together as a family. Those who are not able to meet physically can also join online. Our guests also had a taste of these gatherings.

CORRECTIVE DISCIPLINE OF CHILDREN

The state of the world today presents a rather sad and unfortunate reality. The world offers several shifts from the right order of things as set by the Creator of the Universe. One such paradigm is the egalitarian belief that women are to be equal with men and should strive for a position in the corporate world and not be tied down by the demands of motherhood and her mission field the home. While this may appear glamorous and admirable, it places the care, training and raising of children at stake. Children, as we are all aware, are the "heritage of the LORD." The commission to develop the characters of the children as given by the Lord is ignored and the children grow up having no strength of will or character to counteract the prevailing evils present in our day. Additionally, the influence of the worldly cultures, extended families and indeed the economic burden upon families makes many to feel justified in their path while yet others feel that once they have fed, clothed and sent their children to "good schools," they have done enough. Unknown to them, the work which lies at the very core of their Christian journey is left undone. The building of the character of our children has been neglected for long while many excuses are given.

CORRECTIVE DISCIPLINE OF **CHILDREN**

Corrective discipline is an extension of character building and key foundational work that every parent (especially the mother) needs to learn and be equipped to handle. This is because the enemy desires that one fits into either of the ends of the spectrum -- being indulgent or ruling with iron fist. In other cases, plain neglect or slothfulness exists. Strangely, many parents hold the view that children who are unruly or disobedient are that way naturally and therefore feel no cause to intervene. Others hold the view that children would outgrow these tendencies, while most believers think that they may not need to study and understand what governs the discipline of their children because their children are not predisposed to wrongdoing.

DEFINITIONS

According to the dictionary, the words corrective and discipline have been rendered the following meanings: -

CORRECTIVE

Having the power to correct; having the quality of removing or obviating what is wrong, or injurious; tending to rectify; as corrective penalties.

DISCIPLINE

To instruct or educate; to inform the mind; to prepare by instructing in correct principles and habits; as, to discipline youth for a profession, or for future usefulness.

Combining the two words above, we may agree that corrective discipline involves the process of guiding, teaching and instructing of children to conform to God's will and standards using methods that are loving, redemptive and having the saving nature.

WHY CORRECTIVE DISCIPLINE?

The Holy Bible establishes the fact that "... all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God." (Romans 3:23.) Wrongdoing and disobedience, therefore, are a result of sin.

... Some children are naturally more obstinate than others and will not yield to discipline, and in consequence they make themselves very unattractive and disagreeable. If the mother has not wisdom to deal with this phase of character, a most unhappy state of affairs will follow; for such children will have their own way to their destruction. But how terrible for a child to cherish a spirit of obstinacy not only in childhood, but in more mature years, and because of a lack of agreement in childhood, nourish bitterness and unkindness in manhood and womanhood toward the mother who failed to bring her children under restraint. - CG 237.5.

... If the child has a stubborn will, the mother, if she understands her responsibility, will realize that this stubborn will is part of the inheritance she has given him. She will not look upon his will as something that must be broken. There are times when the determination of the mother meets the determination of the child, when the firm, matured will of the mother meets the unreasoning will of the child, and when either the mother rules because of her advantage of age and experience, or there is a ruling of the older will by the younger, undisciplined will of the child. At such times there is need of great wisdom; for by unwise management, by stern compulsion, the child may be spoiled for this life and the next. By a lack of wisdom everything may be lost. - CG 211.1.

2TG40: 35.3 - There are no problem children, only problem parents and problem environments.

As far as Inspiration is concerned, the cause of obstinacy in a child can be traced to the natural or inherited propensities or tendencies from the parents arising from sin. As sin increases and as a sign of the last days, there will be an increase in disobedience among children even of believers. It is however, sobering to know that this is a phase of character having the prospect of change. It is not a final stage. The environment also plays a role in causing this vice, but the commission, work and indeed the duty lies with the parents. Corrective discipline with the aid of Heaven can and will ensure a right and effectual correction of character.

WHAT MISTAKES DO MOST PARENTS MAKE WHEN IT COMES TO ADMINISTERING **CORRECTIVE DISCIPLINE?**

It is true that every child has at one time or another, done wrong, disobeyed or outrightly been defiant. Therefore, it is imperative that parents, especially, as the teachers and the ones stewarding the children, are equipped with the right tools to handle any situation that demands corrective discipline. The work of parenting and training children for the Kingdom transcends to eternity, therefore, the learning is equally lifelong. Here is what Inspiration says:

Children are often indulged from their babyhood, and wrong habits become fixed. The parents have been bending the sapling. By their course of training the character develops, either into deformity or into symmetry and beauty. But while many err upon the side of indulgence, others go to the opposite extreme and rule their children with a rod of iron. Neither of these follow out the Bible directions, but both are doing a fearful work. They are molding the minds of their children and must render an account in the day of God for the manner in which they have done this. Eternity will reveal the results of the work done in this life. - CG 175.2.

These are among the common mistakes made by many parents while trying to mold the character of their little ones. (for an extensive exposition of these mistakes, refer to Child Guidance chapters 31 to 48.)

- Failing to train children to keep the way of the Lord and yield their will to God.
- Neglecting to give children the watchful care and guidance.
- Failing to properly restrain and direct children due to a blinded love.
- Overlooking and concealing glaring wrongs to save face and avoid offending their children.
- Petting and indulging children as it appears easier and removes them from the responsibility to address any wrongs.
- Sowing seeds of vanity when unnecessarily praise, pet and indulge their children, making them vain, conceited and
- Allowing teenage children to be free from ∇i everyday duties and being enslaved by them.
- $\overline{\mathbf{V}}$ Not establishing the right habits and systems in the home.
- Failing to require obedience, hence being partakers in the very evil deeds committed by their children.
- Allowing children to follow their own minds in favor of the prevailing influences in society.

- Not raising well-adjusted individuals who know their place in life.
- Training as devotees of society while disre- ∇ garding the salvation of their souls.
- Permitting the children to selfishly seek the $\overline{\mathbf{V}}$ happiness of this world as their goal.
- A lack of piety in the home, many Christian homes do not have the operational Word of God in their own lives.
- Parent's own disobedience.
- Postponing the work of training the child.

WHAT THEN SHOULD BE DONE WHEN ADMINISTERING CORRECTIVE DISCIPLINE?

We now attempt to present some of the notable interventions that the parents can undertake as guided by Inspiration:

Obedience From Principle, Not Compulsion.--Tell your children exactly what you require of them. Then let them understand that your word is law and must be obeyed. Thus, you are training them to respect the commandments of God, which plainly declare, "Thou shalt," and "Thou shalt not." It is far better for your boy to obey from principle than from compulsion. - CG 225.1.

Begin early: "The moment that the child begins to choose his own will and way, that moment his education in discipline is to begin. This may be called an unconscious education. It is then that a work, conscious and powerful, is to begin. The greatest burden of this work necessarily rests on the mother. She has the first care of the child, and she is to lay the foundation of an education that will help the child to develop a strong, symmetrical character... " - CG 230.1.

Do not wait for a favorable time: "Neglecting the work of disciplining and training until a perverse disposition has become strengthened is doing the children a most serious wrong; for they grow up selfish, exacting, and unlovable. They cannot enjoy their own company any better than can others; therefore, they will ever be filled with discontent. The work of the mother must commence at an early age, giving Satan no chance to control the minds and dispositions of their little ones." - CG 230.3.

Give Few Commands; Then Require Obedience.--

Let mothers be careful not to make unnecessary requirements to exhibit their own authority before others. Give few commands, but see that these are obeyed. - CG 247.3.

Give this work the seriousness it deserves: The Lord is not glorified when the children are neglected and passed by. They require more than casual notice, more than a word of encouragement. They need painstaking, prayerful, careful labor. - CG 488.2.

Gain an Understanding of Principles Involved.--The lessons learned, the habits formed, during the years of infancy and childhood have more to do with the formation of the character and the direction of the life than have all the instruction and training of after years. - CG 184.3.

Parents need to consider this. They should understand the principles that underlie the care and training of children. They should be capable of rearing them in physical, mental, and moral health. - CG 184.4.

Have the right heart posture: "In all your commands aim to secure the highest good of your children, and then see that these commands are obeyed. Your energy and decision must be unwavering, yet ever in subjection to the Spirit of Christ." - CG 248.1.

Study individual minds and characters: ...All children cannot be treated in the same way, for that restraint which must be kept upon one would crush out the life of another. - CG 205.4.

Be forbearing: If you have children with peculiar temperaments, do not, because of this, let the blight of discouragement rest upon their lives.... Help them by the manifestation of forbearance and sympathy. Strengthen them by loving words and kindly deeds to overcome their defects of character. - CG 208.1.

Teach by Precept and Example. -- In the family, fathers and mothers should ever present before their children the example they wish to be imitated. They should manifest one to the other a tender respect in word, and look, and action. They should make it manifest that the Holy Spirit is controlling them, by representing to

their children the character of Jesus Christ... -CG 215.3.

The powers of imitation are strong in childhood and the parent's voice, tone, spirit and mannerisms are copied by the little ones.

FEW PRACTICAL POINTS TO REMEMBER

First Use Reason and Prayer. -- First reason with your children, clearly point out their wrongs, and impress upon them that they have not only sinned against you, but against God. With your heart full of pity and sorrow for your erring children, pray with them before correcting them. Then they will see that you do not punish them because they have put you to inconvenience, or because you wish to vent your displeasure upon them, but from a sense of duty, for their good; and they will love and respect you. - CG 252.3.

That prayer may make such an impression on their minds that they will see that you are not unreasonable. And if the children see that you are not unreasonable, you have gained a great victory. This is the work that is to be carried on in our family circles in these last days. - CG 253.1.

The following are some of the key points to consider when confronted with a child who needs to be corrected--

- "Disobedience must be punished. Wrongdoing must be corrected." - CG 249.4. As every individual circumstance varies, so should the approach of the parent. The spirit may lead one to follow the next best action. Bear in mind that this must be done promptly, wisely and firmly.
- Ask the Lord to subdue and soften their heart before you correct the erring child. Sometimes even when punishment is required, the Lord may cause the erring child to humble themselves and acknowledge their wrongs -- in which case that is enough. Simply explain to them and have them understand that they they should not repeat the mistake. (See CG chapter
- In the face of defiance, the parent should be patient, firm and loving. If punishment becomes necessary, let it be clear that it is not done in anger. "That is the time of all times when you should act with humility and patience and prayer. Then is the time to kneel down with the children and ask the Lord for pardon. Seek to

- win them to Christ by the manifestation of kindness and love, and you will see that a higher power than that of earth is co-operating with your efforts." - CG 245.6. "When you are obliged to correct a child, do not raise the voice to a high key. . . . Do not lose your self-control. The parent who, when correcting a child, gives way to anger is more at fault than the child." - CG 246.1.
- While correcting children, parents are to avoid nervousness, impatience and lack of calm and self-control. This may cause the whole household to be fretful, miserable and unhappy and everything goes wrong. The real cause here is the parent as their spirit sets the tone for the family and leads to greater evil. (See CG 247.1)
- "There is sometimes power in silence. When in danger to speak unwisely, impatiently, it is better to be silent until one is sure to not say anything that would dishonor the Lord." - CG
- Make them give an account: "A neglectful child should be called to account for their neglect or unfaithfulness." - CG 248.2. If for instance, a child has been given the task to perform such as cleaning the dishes after a meal, call them to explain the reasons why they have not performed the task and explain to them that they are to bear the burden of responsibility as members of the household. Then require them to clean the dishes and make sure to see to it that it is done.
- Be consistent: Parents to act from principle and not impulse. One cannot pass over a wrongdoing today and the next day punish a child over the same wrong. This is doing contrary to the what the Lord requires (justice and judgement). See CG 248.4.
- Some children will soon forget a wrong that is done to them by father and mother; but other children who are differently constituted cannot forget severe, unreasonable punishment which they did not deserve. Thus, their souls are injured, and their minds bewildered. The mother loses her opportunities to instill right principles into the mind of the child, because she did not maintain self-control and manifest a wellbalanced mind in her deportment and words. -
- Be so calm, so free from anger that they will be convinced that you love them, even though you punish them. - CG 249.2.
- Inducements Are Sometimes Better Than **Punishment:** Children naturally desire to please the parents. If at the beginning of the day, clear, simple and reasonable rules, instructions and outcomes are given and repeated, children are more likely to avoid doing wrong and aim to do that which will make their parents happy while getting the outcome of their choices. (See CG

- The Rod Is Sometimes Necessary, As the Last Resort: "Whipping may be necessary when other resorts fail, yet she should not use the rod if it is possible to avoid doing so. But if milder measures prove insufficient, punishment that will bring the child to its senses should in love be administered. Frequently one such correction will be enough for a lifetime, to show the child that he does not hold the lines of control." - CG 250.2. "And when this step becomes necessary, the child should be seriously impressed with the thought that this is not done for the gratification of the parent, or to indulge arbitrary authority, but for the child's own good. He should be taught that every fault uncorrected will bring unhappiness to himself and will displease God. Under such discipline children will find their greatest happiness in submitting their wills to the will of the heavenly Father." - CG 250.3. Normally, you will find that if you reason with children kindly, they will not need to be whipped. This method will lead them to have confidence in you. They will make you their confidant. They will come to you and say, I did wrong today at such a time, and I want you to forgive me and to ask God to forgive me.
- "Do not threaten them with the wrath of God if they do wrong, but bring them in your prayers to Christ." - CG 253.2. Giving threats every time a child does wrong will have them accustomed to the threats and they may not have any effect on them; or they may act out of fear and not conviction.
- "Follow the Divine Guidebook.-- The Bible is a guide in the management of children. Here, if parents desire, they may find a course marked out for the education and training of their children, that they may make no blunders." - CG **256.2**. There is no better position for a parent to administer correction/discipline than from the authoritative power and principle of God's Word. It is a firm foundation.

WHAT IS THE GOAL OF EVERY **PARENT?**

3SC3-4: 6.2.1 - "These facts must be pressed home upon parents; they must arouse, and take up their long-neglected work...

Those who have been training their children in an improper way need not despair; let them become converted to God and seek for the true spirit of obedience, and they will be enabled to make decided reforms. In conforming your own customs to the saving principles of God's holy law, you will have

an influence upon your children. - CG 173.2.

...Parents, when you have faithfully done your duty, to the extent of your ability, you may then in faith ask the Lord to do that for your children which you cannot do. - CG 256.4.

After you have done your duty faithfully to your children, then carry them to God and ask Him to help you. Tell Him that you have done your part, and then in faith ask God to do His part, that which you cannot do. Ask Him to temper their dispositions, to make them mild and gentle by His Holy Spirit. He will hear you pray. He will love to answer your prayers. Through His Word He has enjoined it upon you to correct your children, to "spare not for their crying," and His Word is to be heeded in these things. - CG 256.5.

CONCLUSION

Our God has so richly blessed us with the pattern to follow in His Word as we are on a course in seeing families reformed. One who desires to bind the heart of their children to themselves needs not only learn the theory but practically avail themselves to the responsibility it calls for. responsibility it calls for, and reconcile to the fact that this work cannot be transferred and that the souls of the children are of inestimable worth. Corrective discipline is an important branch of parenting that if correctly and fearfully done, will result in raising the ranks in the Lord's army. Where are the parents of our day who are willing to take bold steps leading to the "well done [thou] good and faithful servant?"

ACTIVITY FOR ALL

The activity below is an exercise that parents and others who may be interested may take part in. The activity contains four scenarios that are adapted from real life experiences. Members are asked to read through each scenario carefully and then for each scenario, attend to the following questions or instructions.

Which of the given scenarios is the correct response according to Inspiration?

- ✓ Please identify what is wrong in any scenario deemed as incorrect.
- Provide the correct response for each incorrect one.

Members are free to post their responses and relevant comments, and other similar topics on the Family Life WhatsApp group for the benefit of many. By God's grace, the FLD answers and comments shall be given in the next issue of the Symbolic Code.

PRACTICAL SCENARIOS

- 1. A 5-year-old child is told to eat their vegetables. She refuses and states that she does not like the taste of the vegetables. The mother, who is visibly angered, tries to explain to the child that God is the one who gave us this diet and it is good for our health. The mother then proceeds to ask the child to continue eating. The child obliges and continues to eat.
- 2. A single mother is engaged in a Zoom meeting which she joined using her phone, being the Reformation Sabbath. Her 2-year-old son curiously runs to her and tries to grab the phone. The mother firmly and calmly tells the son to stop. She then explains to the child that she needs to attend the meeting and she requires that he be quiet and stop disturbing her. She is later seen giving the boy an iPad to use to watch some Bible stories. The boy is thoroughly engaged and maintains the silence. The mother continues to attend the meeting that continues for the next two hours.
- 3. A teenage girl tells her mother that she wishes to confide in her about something that is bothering her. She tells her mother that she has recently started feeling uncomfortable wearing a head covering to their SDA Sabbath worship meetings as many of the people of her age seem to avoid her or perceive her to be unusual. She then suggests that they stop attending church at the SDA church in their locality and only attend the DSDA gatherings in their area where their dressing is not a not a spectacle.

- In the alternative, she asks to be allowed to go to Church without a head covering. Her mother is touched by this revelation and proceeds to open Inspiration on the segment for advanced Christian dressing for Davidians and reminds her daughter what is required of her from the Lord. She further reminds her of the impending slaughter that shall take place in God's church emphasizing that if we disobey, we shall be killed. God is a sin-hating God and He will not tolerate any disobedience. The conversation ends with a hug and the daughter says that she shall no longer think to do such a thing.
- 4. A 9-year-old boy is clearly absorbed in watering the garden. This is a chore that he enjoys and would sometimes forget to attend to other tasks given to him by his father. He loves to care for the plants and the family enjoys the fresh meals that result from his good work. Just this moment, his father calls him to the house and asks him if he had made his bed before going off to water the vegetables. He responds that he had forgotten to do it and would do it after he was done with the gardening. An hour passes and the boy is now engrossed in reading of the children's booklet from the Children's Department that contains lessons on various topics for the little lambs. The father walks into his room and notices the unmade bed, but quickly realizes that his son is reading the Word of God. As this is a habit he has been trying to instill and teach his son, he clearly understands the good intention and decides to encourage him on his reading and does not mention his bed which is still not made. He reasons that it wouldn't be necessary to disturb him but rather, ask him to do it later. The day ends on a high note. The boy sleeps in his unmade bed but he has read Word of God. Both the father and the son seem satisfied.

Greetings of peace beloved Brothers and Sisters!

God, who alone sees the desires and pains of every heart, did not overlook the tearful pleas of a woman named Hannah as she poured out her heart to the Lord, asking for the one gift she longed for above any other earthly blessing. As that gift came forth into the world, she sounded her gratitude in Spirit-filled praise:

1 Sam. 2:1-10-- And Hannah prayed, and said, My heart rejoiceth in the LORD, mine horn is exalted in the LORD: my mouth is enlarged over mine enemies; because I rejoice in thy salvation. [There is] none holy as the LORD: for [there is] none beside thee: neither [is there] any rock like our God. Talk no more so exceeding proudly; let [not] arrogancy come out of your mouth: for the LORD [is] a God of knowledge, and by him actions are weighed. The bows of the mighty men [are] broken, and they that stumbled are girded with strength. He will keep the feet of his saints, and the wicked shall be silent in darkness; for by strength shall no man prevail. The adversaries of the LORD shall be broken to pieces; out of heaven shall he thunder upon them: the LORD shall judge the ends of the earth; and he shall give strength unto his king, and exalt the horn of his anointed.

This gift eventually became one of the most significant prophets in Bible history. The upbringing and childhood of Samuel are a testament to the importance of early training and capacity building children when they are brought up in the Lord. The best we can do with our God-given gifts is to give them back to God. This is what we ought to do with our children, for:

Ps. 127:3-- Lo, children [are] an heritage of the LORD: [and] the fruit of the womb [is his] reward.

As younger members of the family of God, they are in no wise to be underestimated, but rather, nurtured and trained to offer the Lord acceptable service even at a tender age, like the little Jewish girl who directed the Syrian commander to the prophet of God for healing.

Iesus said:

Matt. 19:14-- But Jesus said, Suffer little children, and forbid them not, to come unto me: for of such is the kingdom of heaven.

The Saviour loved children and esteemed childlikeness, even making it a condition to entering His Kingdom. This speaks volumes about the importance of raising children on firm principles and guiding these little lambs in the footsteps of the Good Shepherd.

As believers of the Elijah Message which is to "restore all things and turn the hearts of fathers to their children", a most solemn obligation rests on us to ensure that the little lambs in our midst are nourished in the ways of God.

Inspiration says:

Make a Right Beginning .-- Your children are God's property, bought with a price. Be very particular, 0 fathers and mothers, to treat them in a Christlike manner. - CG 27.2

Light has been shining from the Word of God and the testimonies of His Spirit so that none need err in regard to their duty. God requires parents to bring up their children to know Him and to respect His claims; they are to train their little ones, as the younger members of the Lord's family, to have beautiful characters and lovely tempers, that they may be fitted to shine in the heavenly courts. By neglecting their duty and indulging their children in wrong, parents close to them the gates of the city of God. These facts must be pressed home upon parents; they must arouse and take up their long-neglected work. - Testimonies for the church, Vol. 5, pp. 325, 326. - CG 13.2

As we near the shores of the Kingdom, we ought to pay earnest attention to the development of our children, constantly asking the Lord for wisdom and guidance to train up His heritage in the way they must go. They can indeed play an active part in ushering in the Kingdom long hoped for. We ought to inspire in them the zeal that is needed at this late hour. We read of a remarkable occurrence in the days of the prophet;

1SC11,12: 7.9 - ...Furthermore, we are having an increasing number of young people and children who are attending our services, and who are desirous of helping to give the message to the church, and be one of those who shall receive the seal and become a part of the "servants of God," and they, too, are watching us.

That we will work tirelessly towards having our children come up to the help of the Lord in an even greater manner than aforementioned, is our prayer and also one of the main objectives of organizing the children's department. With the cooperation of the parents, and wisdom from above, we strive to raise up in our midst an army of little soldiers ever ready to serve the Lord, children well pleasing to Him, children truly wondered at.

I WRITE UNTO YOU EATHERS

Greetings, dearly beloved,

In this article of the Symbolic Code, we are pleased to present a letter addressed to all fathers within our Church. Whether you are a father by blood or a guardian by duty, we implore you to heed these solemn admonitions, delivered by the Voice of God through His **Rod** that speaketh:

TN13: 20.3 - "I WRITE UNTO YOU, FATHERS, because ye have known Him that is from the beginning."

Let us begin this letter from where it began:

SR2: 168.3 - In the beginning God created both the man and the woman equal, as king and queen. "And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish thfe earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over

the owl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth." (Gen. 1:28.) Note that the dominion was given to them both. However, after they sinned a change was made: "Unto the woman He said,... thy desire shall be to thy husband, and He shall rule over thee." (Gen. 3:16.) So, after the woman sinned she fell under the government of man. But that which Eve lost by deception, shall be restored by redemption. Thus again the equality of both shall be established as kings and queens. Therefore, "There is neither male nor female in Christ Jesus." Christ himself confirms the idea in the following expression: "For when they shall rise from the dead, they neither marry, nor are given in marriage, but are as the angels which are in heaven."

Here God speaks of how man and woman

shared the same equality and He continues to say that sin led to the loss of this state of equality. But the promise is sure, "...that which was lost by deception shall be restored by redemption...." Let us hear the **Rod** butter:

1SC7: 10.7 - "My husband then swung himself over the fearful abyss into the beautiful field beyond. I immediately followed. And oh, what a sense of relief and gratitude to God we felt! I heard voices raised in triumphant praise to God. I was happy, perfectly happy.

Dear fathers, are we seeing the days we are living in and faithfully performing our duties?

2SC11: 3.2.5 - Fathers, are you still at the same old ways -- either paying no attention to, or injudiciously ruling, your children? The Lord has appointed the youth to be His helping hand. - FLB 332.2

The cause of God demands the highest powers of the being, and there is urgent need in many fields for young men of literary qualifications. There is need of men who can be trusted to labor in extensive fields that are now white to the harvest. Young men of ordinary ability, who give themselves wholly to God, who are uncorrupted by vice and impurity, will be successful, and will be enabled to do a great work for God. Let young men heed the admonition, and be sober-minded. - MYP 22.2

We the youth and young adults being so much privileged to be God's helping hand, our attention is now called forth to our first duty:

But first the young men who would serve God, and give themselves to His work, must cleanse the soul temple of all impurity, and enthrone Christ in the heart; then they will be enabled to put energy into their Christian effort, and will manifest enthusiastic zeal in persuading men to be reconciled to Christ. Will not our young men respond to the invitation of Christ, and answer, "Here am I; send me"? Young men, press to the front, and identify yourselves as laborers together with Christ, taking up the work where He left it, to carry it on to its completion. -- Review and Herald, June 16, 1891. - MYP 25.1

I entreat of you, careless, reckless youth of today, be converted, and become laborers together with God. Let it be the study of your life to bless and save others. If you seek help from God, His power working in you will bring to naught all opposing powers, and you will become sanctified through the truth. Sin is alarmingly prevalent among the youth of today, but let it be your purpose to do what you can to rescue souls from the

power of Satan. - MYP 22.4

Be Light Bearers

Carry light wherever you go; show that you have strength of purpose, that you are not a person of indecision, easily swayed by the persuasions of evil associates. Do not yield a ready assent to the suggestions of those who dishonor God, but rather seek to reform, reclaim, and rescue souls from evil. - MYP 23.1

1TG2: 28:2 - We need young evangelists, converted boys and girls to work for the unconverted, to exert the right kind of influence over other boys and girls. This is essential because converted boys and girls do more for their own age than can the older people. Then, too, we need young men and young women to help the boys and the girls in soul-winning work — not to preach to them, but to lead them.

Thus a need for whole hearted service:

1TG2: 29:3 - Joseph and Samuel did the essential thing. They put their whole hearts into whatever they did. All the great men in the world do and that is why they are great. Whatever you boys and girls do, really do it. No fooling about it. In the end of each day you should be able to say, "My work was almost perfect, and my deeds unquestionable." This you can do. Go to the "Door," and tell Him your needs and your trials. Say, "Lord, my trials are Your trials. I will not let them trouble me any longer. I will put my heart and soul into Thy work."

CONCLUSION WITH AN APPEAL AND SOLEMN WARNING

2SC11: 4.2.2 - "How can I endure the thought that most of the youth in this age will come

short of everlasting life! Oh that the sound of instrumental music might cease, and they no more while away so much precious time in pleasing their own fancy. Oh that they would devote less time to dress and vain conversation, and send forth their earnest, agonizing prayers to God, for a sound experience. There is great necessity for close self-examination in the light of God's Word; let each one raise the inquiry, 'Am I sound, or am I rotten at heart? Am I renewed in Christ, or am I still carnal at heart, with a new dress put on the outside?' Rein yourself

up to the great tribunal, and in the light of God examine to see if there be any secret sin that you are cherishing, any idol that you have not sacrificed. Pray, yes, pray as you have never prayed before, that you may not be deluded by Satan's devices, that you may not be given up to a heedless, careless, vain spirit, and attend to religious duties to quiet your own conscience." -- "Testimonies for the Church," Vol. 2, p. 144.

GET READY, GET READY

As we begin this study, let us reflect on what it means to truly prepare our lives and hearts. Are we living each day with the awareness that God's Kingdom is near? Are we aligning our thoughts, actions, and faith in ways that draw us closer to Him? Today, let us explore the call to get ready for God's promises, and in doing so, find purpose and peace in the nearness of His Kingdom.

The warning sounds down along the line to us in this generation. Are you, 0 careless heart, a fruitless tree in the Lord's vineyard? Shall the words of doom erelong be spoken of you? How long have you received His gifts? How long has He watched and waited for a return of love? Planted in His vineyard, under the watchful care of the gardener, what privileges are yours! How often has the tender gospel message thrilled your heart! You have taken the name of Christ, you are outwardly a member of the church which is His body, and yet you are conscious of no living connection with the great heart of love. The tide of His life does not flow through you. The sweet graces of His character, "the fruits of the Spirit," are not seen in your life" - COL 216.3

Prepare to meet thy God, O Israel. Amos 4:12. - Mar 98.1

Suppose that today Christ should appear in the clouds of heaven, who . . . would be ready to meet Him? Suppose we should be translated

into the kingdom of heaven just as we are. Would we be prepared to unite with the saints of God, to live in harmony with the royal family, the children of the heavenly King? What preparation have you made for the judgment? Have you made your peace with God? Are you laboring together with God? Are you seeking to help those around you, those in your home, those in your neighborhood, those with whom you come in contact that are not keeping the commandments of God? . . . Are we getting ready to meet the King? . . . - Mar 98.2

Inspiration is telling us to examine our readiness for Christ's return. If He appeared today, would we truly be prepared to join the saints in God's Kingdom? It's a call to reflect on our relationship with God, our dedication to His work, and how we're impacting those around us. Being ready isn't just about a future event; it's about daily living that mirrors Christ's love and truth. Each day is an opportunity to make peace with God, serve others, and live in a way that aligns with His Kingdom. Are we prepared to live as part of His royal family?

SR2: 295.1 – Note that the reason the waters are healed, is because they are "brought forth into the sea." If the mighty river represents the saints from the earth, then the sea must be a symbol of the sinless worlds (inhabitants) in the universe of God. As the river is brought into the sea, it denotes that the saints shall come in contact with the eternal nations who know not sin, and being "brought forth," we must be "healed" before we meet each other! The facts of this symbol prove that this is the last section of God's church -- the church that shall be translated without tasting death! Get ready, get ready, get ready, we are now standing on the winds of eternity -- life that shall never cease.

2SC7,8: 6.1.4 - "Then I was pointed to the earth, and saw that there would have to be a getting ready among those who have of late embraced the third angel's message. Said the angel, 'Get ready, get ready, get ready. Ye will have to die a greater death to the world than ye have ever yet died.' I saw that there was a great work to do for them, and but little time in which to do it..."

If it were possible for us to be admitted into heaven as we are, how many of us would be able to look upon God? How many of us have on the wedding-garment? How many of us are without spot or wrinkle or any such thing? How many of us are worthy to receive the crown of life? . . . Position does not make the man. It is Christ formed within that makes a man worthy of receiving the crown of life, that fadeth not away. - Mar 98.3

Our readiness for Heaven isn't based on outward status or achievements but on our inner transformation through Christ. If we were to stand before God today, would our hearts be clothed in the purity He desires? The wedding garment represents a life surrendered, refined, and made worthy by Jesus within us. True worthiness comes from being molded by Christ, letting His Spirit remove every "spot or wrinkle" in us. It's a call to seek inner change, letting Him prepare us fully to receive the crown of life that never fades.

I was pointed to the remnant on the earth. The angel said to them, "Will ye shun the seven last plagues? . . . If so, ye must die that ye may live. Get ready, get ready, get ready. Ye must have a greater preparation than ye now have. ... Sacrifice all to God. Lay all upon His altar--self, property, and all, a living sacrifice. It will take all to enter glory." - Mar 98.4

Christ is coming with power and great glory. He is coming with His own glory and with the glory of the Father. . . . While the wicked flee from His presence, Christ's followers will rejoice. . . . To His faithful followers Christ has been a daily companion and familiar friend. They have lived in close contact, in constant communion with God. Upon them the glory of the Lord has risen. . . . Now they rejoice in the undimmed rays of the brightness and glory of the King in His majesty. They are prepared for the communion of heaven; for they have heaven in their hearts. - Mar 98.5

"Get ready," is the word sounded in my ears. "Get ready, get ready. He that is to come, will come and will not tarry. Tell my people that unless they improve the sacred opportunities given them, unless they do the work I have given them, Satan will come upon them with the stealthy tread of a thief, to deceive and allure them." God wants us to be wide awake, that when He shall come, we shall be ready to say, "Lo, this is our God; we have waited for Him, and He will save us." He is coming to us by His Holy Spirit today. Let us recognize Him now; then we shall recognize Him when He comes in the clouds of heaven, with power and great glory. God calls upon you to get ready to meet Him in peace. - RH, April 30, 1901 par. 8

This Message calls us to wake up spiritually and make the most of every opportunity that God gives us. "Get ready, get ready, get ready" echoes as an urgent reminder that Christ's return is certain and near. If we are not alert and committed to God's work, we risk being misled by the enemy's subtle deceptions. But God does not just call us to be prepared for a future moment—He calls us to recognize and welcome His presence through the Holy Spirit today. By walking closely with Him now, we'll be ready to joyfully say, "Lo, this is our God; we have waited for Him, and He will save us" when He comes in all His glory.

The Lord is coming. Time is short. Get ready, get ready, get ready. For Christ's sake call a halt; you have not a moment to lose. Put an end to all unjust, unrighteous criticism, and humble your hearts before God. "Seek ye the

Prepare yourself, be vigilant, be steadfast—be ready for the Lord's return.


